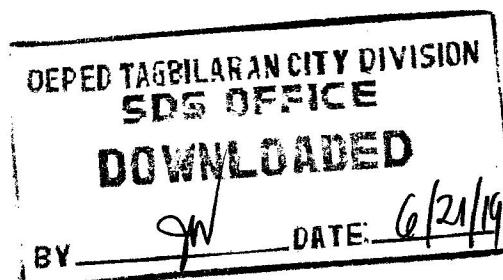
**ANNOUNCING THE AVAILABILITY OF e-CITIZENSHIP, AN e-BOOK
