The Bohol Arts and Cultural Heritage (BACH) Institute, in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), Provincial Government of Bohol, Diocese of Tagbilaran and the Loboc Youth Education Association (LYEA) Corp. will be organizing the *Heritage Writeshop on Place, Memory and Food* on July 8-11, 2019.




