

SUBJECT : **CONDUCT OF 2019 OPLAN SA KALUSUGAN (OK) SA DepEd ONE HEALTH WEEK ACTIVITIES**

DATE : **July 5, 2019**

1. Pursuant to Department of Education Order No. 28, s. 2018 titled " Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)," all public schools are enjoined to observe a nationwide **OK sa DepEd One Health Week on July 22-26, 2019. The National Kick-Off for OK sa DepEd will be on July 24, 2019 at Banisil Elem. School, General Santos City** and to be spearheaded by the Bureau of Learners Support Services-School Health Division. The One Health Week will roll out health activities giving focus on the six Major Flagship School Health Programs :
 - 1) School-Based Feeding Program
 - 2) National Drug Education Program (NDEP)
 - 3) Adolescent Reproductive Health Program (ARH)
 - 4) Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program
 - 5) Medical, Dental and Nursing Services
 - 6) School Mental Health Program
2. One Health Week shall be maximized to mobilize the community and promote collaboration with partners and stakeholders especially at the school level. As such, schools are tasked to network with partners within their localities for various health endeavors such as the improvement and maintenance of health facilities; provision of health and nutrition services including manpower, medicines, and equipment; and finalization of deliverables and schedule of joint health activities for the school year. Schools should coordinate with their division health personnel for the conduct of the activities. During the One Health Week, Schools Division Offices, elementary and secondary schools are enjoined to undertake the following suggested activities:
 - 1) Orientation of parents, communities, partners and stakeholders;
 - 2) Delivery of age-appropriate health services (medical, dental & nursing services)
 - 3) Launching of age-appropriate health and hygiene practices;
 - 4) Conduct of feeding activities and school gardening activities;
 - 5) Exhibits/for a on the NDEP, ARH, school mental health and comprehensive tobacco control;
 - 6) Open house of canteens featuring healthy food and beverage choices;
3. In this connection, Schools Division Offices shall conduct kick-off activities on or before July 22, 2019 to signal the start of One Health Week and gain support from partners and stakeholders. Funds to support the division kick-off activities and other related Ok sa DepEd health activities will be charge to downloaded funds. Schools shall ensure that all activities be documented following the data requirements of the OK sa DepEd Forms A and B attached to DO 28, s. 2018 for the submission of reports.
