**2019 MTAP-DEPED SATURDAY PROGRAMS IN MATHEMATICS
FOR REGULAR AND TALENTED LEARNERS**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory No. 105, s. 2019, dated June 27, 2019, the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) Inc., announces the offering of the *2019 MTAP-DepEd Saturday Programs in Mathematics for Regular and Talented Learners*.
2. The program for regular learners aims to:
 - a. provide the learners with the opportunity to explore Mathematics without the threat of tests;
 - b. **review them on the materials** covered in the last school year to enable them **to do well in Mathematics** in the present school year; and
 - c. **prepare Grade 6 and Grade 10 learners** for their entrance examinations.
3. The program for regular learners will be conducted from Grades 1 to 11 for six Saturdays, 8:00 am to 12:00 noon from August 10 to September 14, 2019. There are six centers for the elementary schools namely, Tagbilaran City Central Elementary School, Tagbilaran City Central SPED Center-Special Science Elementary School, City East Elementary School, Cogon Elementary School, Dao Elementary School and Manga Elementary School while Tagbilaran City Science High School and Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School are the centers for the secondary schools. A written permit from the parents is necessary.
4. The program for talented learners will be conducted from October 26 to December 14, 2019 (seven Saturdays). It aims to:
 - a. prepare the Grade 6 and 10 learners for their entrance examinations, and
 - b. train them for the Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge.
5. A registration fee in the amount of Two Hundred pesos (Program for Regular Learners) and Two Hundred Fifty pesos (Program for Talented Learners) will be collected from each participant for the whole series of sessions to defray the expenses incurred in the conduct of the program
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
