1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID), celebrates the **2019 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week** with the theme *Lokal na Pamahalaan: Kabalik sa Pagtupad ng Karapatan ng mga Taong May Kapansanan* from **July 17 to 23, 2019**. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation (PP) No. 1870, s. 1979. The observance culminates on the birthdate of the Sublime Paralytic: Apolinario Mabini on July 23 of every year pursuant to PP No. 361, s. 2000.

2. The celebration aims to stimulate public awareness on the issues and problems of disability. Hence, everyone is encouraged to participate and take an active role in the upliftment of the economic and social conditions of Persons With Disabilities (PWDs) in the country.

3. As a member of the governing board created by the National Council on Disability Affairs (NCDA), the DepEd supports the observance of said celebration by undertaking the following activities:

- a. Hanging of advocacy streamers in conspicuous places of schools/offices. Format is provided in Enclosure No. 1;
- b. Submission of Agency Feedback Report (AFR), using the AFR Form contained in Enclosure No. 2, upon culmination of the celebration; and
- c. Participation in activities organized by the LGUs and Disabled People's Organizations (DPOs), in which the Calendar of Activities is indicated in Enclosure No. 3.

4. The schools can select appropriate school activities, which can be conducted at the school and/or schools division levels. All Special Education (SPED) centers, and public and private schools with SPED programs are encouraged to undertake activities relevant to the theme of this year's celebration. However, all activities to be undertaken should not disrupt classes nor compromise their supervision pursuant to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled **Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith**.

5. Relative to the celebration of the NDPR Week, all SPED centers and schools with SPED programs must accomplish the AFR Form and submit it to the BLD-SID.
