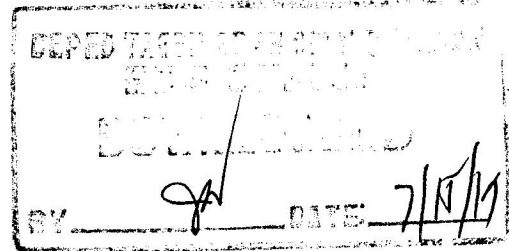

- reinforce the basics of written English and practice writing through a variety of tasks





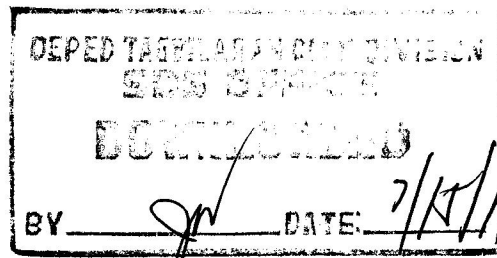


Dear Dr. Ojastro:
