Conduct of Simultaneous 4-O'clock Habit (Massive Search and

Destroy) para Deng-Get Out Activities.

In reference to the declaration of the National Dengue Epidemic in the country, there is a need to heighten vector control activities as one of the primary interventions to prevent and control dengue.

In Central Visayas, a total of 11,085 cases, 74 deaths, and Case Fatality Rate (CFR) of 0.7% were reported from the different disease reporting units for the period of 01 January 2019 to 03 August 2019 (31st morbidity week). 118% higher compared to that of the same period of the previous year with 5,095 cases, 30 deaths and 0.6% CFR.

In view of this, we enjoined everyone to participate in the conduct of the Simultaneous 4-O'clock Habit para Deng-Get Out Activities starting on 13 August 2019, Tuesday at 4:00 pm and onwards until such that the dengue outbreak declaration be lifted. Massive search and destroy will be simultaneously conducted to all possible breeding sites and intensify information dissemination with participation of the general public whether they are at the community, workplaces or schools to make it a regular 4 O'clock habit. Furthermore, we encourage checking and reviewing of health unit's readiness to provide dengue prevention services.
