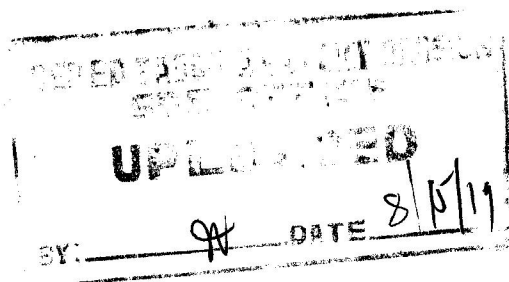

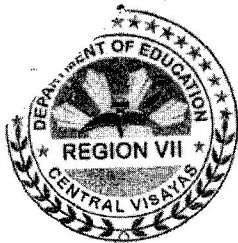
PROVISION OF INSECTICIDAL NETS FOR SCHOOLS AGAINST DENGUE

PROVISION OF INSECTICIDAL NETS FOR SCHOOLS AGAINST DENGUE

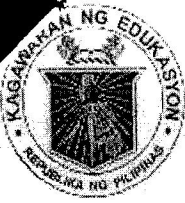
TO: **SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS**

1. The Department of Health (DOH) declared a National Dengue Alert last July 15, 2019 due to the rapid increase in the number of dengue cases in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao from January – June 2019. This calls for an **URGENT response** to all government agencies, including the Department of Education (DepEd) to address the health issue.
2. In this regard, emphasis of the urgency of the anti-dengue drive is of utmost importance in the Department of Education and the Department of Health (DOH). The DOH Central Office, as part of the anti-dengue campaign has prepositioned **insecticidal nets** at their regional offices and instructed for the distribution **for free** to affected areas.
3. Furthermore, Schools Division Offices with dengue outbreak are to coordinate with their respective Regional DOH Offices for the free insecticidal nets to protect our learners and personnel in schools. Please refer to attached communication for more of the details.

In relation to the National Dengue Alert declared by the Department of Health (DOH) last 15 July 2019 because of the increasing number of dengue cases reported in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao from January-June 2019, the regional DOH offices set-up dengue surveillance, case management and outbreak response in primary health facilities and hospitals, as well as through community and school-based health education campaigns.
