**DIVISION ORIENTATION ON SCHOOL GOVERNING COUNCIL (SGC)**

1. The Philippine Education for All (EFA) 2015 Plan is a vision and a holistic program of reforms that aim to improve the quality of basic education for every Filipino. To attain EFA, schools should continuously improve its performance. The key action involves the school's assessment of its capabilities and performance towards attaining EFA goals. The stakeholders of every school (school head, teachers, parents, students, community leaders, other groups interested in school practices) shall be able to use processes and results to determine and implement school programs to ensure continuous improvement in school quality.

2. With this, Tagbilaran City Division will conduct a one-day "Division-wide SGC Orientation" on **September 10, 2019, Panda Tea Garden, J.A., Clarin Street, Tagbilaran City**. The said activity envisioned every school to create a network of community-based groups to a popular movement featuring a wide variety of local initiatives (a kind of "thousand flowers bloom" movement) by individuals, local governments, communities, civil society organizations and other interest groups and associations. This vision will be attained through the creation of the School Governing Council (SGC) in the schools.


3. The School Governing Council provides a forum for parents, students, teachers, community stakeholders and the school head to work together towards continuously improving student learning outcomes. SGCs provide the opportunity and the environment to develop shared responsibility in the children's learning and holistic development.

4. The objective of this one-day activity primarily aimed to review the DepEd School Governing Council Guidelines and its guiding principles, governance, limitations and its role in the entire school community in incorporating learning resources into the improvement processes of the school.

5. Participants of the said one-activity are School SBM Coordinator/SGC School Coordinator, SGC President, Principals, Asst. School Principals and Head Teachers of the 24 public schools in Tagbilaran City.

6. Expenses relative to and in the conduct of this Division Orientation on School Governing Council (SGC) shall be charge to Division HRDD funds while a registration fee of P450.00 per School Governing Council representative (particularly the Chairman of each school) shall be collected chargeable to School Funds subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
