**CONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL ANTI- DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (PADAC)
 IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL PROVIDING FOR ITS NEW MEMBERSHIP AND
 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

“WHEREAS, Republic Act 9165 otherwise known as THE Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act 2002 provides that it is the policy of the state to safeguard the integrity of its territory and the well – being of its citizenry particularly the youth from the harmful effects of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well – being and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and development and preservation;

“WHEREAS, same law states that the government shall pursue an intensive and unrelenting campaign against the trafficking and use of dangerous drugs and other similar substances through an integrated system of planning, implementation and enforcement of anti – drug abuse policies, programs and projects;

“WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum, Circular No. 98 – 227 dated December 2, 1998, 99 -226 dated December 21, 1999 and 2001 – 90 dated July 26, 2001 all pertaining to the creation of Anti – Drug Abuse Councils directed all Provincial Governors, City / Municipal Mayors and Punong Barangays to create reactivate and strengthen their respective local ADACs;

“WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 14, CY 1997 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bohol created the Provincial Anti – Drug Abuse Councils and whose composition was amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 2011 – 016 to conform with DILG Memorandum Circular No 98 – 227; and

“WHEREAS, in the light of the assumption of new set of provincial, municipal officials as well as agencies concerned and in order to strengthen the Council to address some issues and concerns prevailing in our communities nowadays involving illegal drugs, there is a need to constitute the said Council;

“NOW, THEREFORE, I **ATTY. ARTHUR C. YAP**, Governor, Province of Bohol by virtue of the power and authority vested in the under Sec. 465 (b) (2) (iii) of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) and other laws of the Republic of the Philippines and in consonance with Provincial Ordinance No. 2001 – 016, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. Constitution of the Provincial Anti – Drug Abuse Council. – The Provincial Anti – Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) of the Province of Bohol is hereby constituted as follows:

SECTION 2. Functions. – The Committee shall perform the following:

- a.) Serve as focal point through which various organizations and individuals work together in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;
- b.) Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of exiting services and programs on drug abuse prevention;
- c.) Conduct information and education on the ill effects if illegal drugs, monitor and report to proper authorities drug pushers and drug users in the locality;
- d.) Prepare a confidential watch list of drug pushers and users in the LGU's area of jurisdiction to be submitted to the P"NP Anti – Illegal Drug Task Force for the latter's validation or verification leading to the arrest and filing of appropriate charges; and
- e.) Perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

SECTION 3. Meetings. – The Council shall meet every quarter or as often as may be necessary.

SECTION 4. Secretariat. – The Secretariat of the Council shall be headed by Dr. Cesar Tomas Lopez, Provincial Health Officer 1 and Head of CEDEC.
