

2019 WORLD FOOD DAY DIVISION ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

**To : PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HEADS
CONCERNED PERSONNEL**

1. The Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations, in partnership with Department of Education (Dep-Ed) will conduct the 2019 World Food Day Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest on September 26, 2019 at Azia Suites and Residences, Barangay Kamputhaw, Cebu City with the theme "Our Actions are our Future, Healthy Diets for a #Zero Hunger World."
2. The contest is opened to all Grade IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd accredited private elementary schools. The top three (3) division winners are eligible to participate in the regional level competition and shall be provided the necessary materials needed at the venue during the said contest.
3. In view of this, the Division level competition is scheduled on September 19, 2019 at the City Division Conference Hall, Dampas District, Tagbilaran City, 8:30 in the morning. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials to be used in the contest. Please see the attached Contest Mechanics and the Criteria for Judging.

**Guidelines for the Conduct of the 2019 World Food Day
National and Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contests**

1. The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd accredited private schools nationwide. Previous national winners of this contest need not join.
2. Only one (1) contestant per region, endorsed by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee will be qualified to join the National On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest.
3. Students shall be allowed to have one (1) coach or one (1) guardian.
4. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot at the regional and national levels. (Division/District level contest may be conducted provided that expenses to be incurred shall be shouldered by the DepEd or DA regional offices).
5. Contestants are not allowed to bring their own materials. Materials to be used for the Poster Making Contest shall be limited to an illustration board (20" x 30"), oil pastel and pentel pen to be provided by the Contest Committee during the regional and national contests.
6. The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
7. Judging shall immediately commence after all entries have been submitted. Coaches, guardians and participants will not be allowed to enter the contest venue while evaluation of the Board of Judges (BOJ) is on-going.
8. The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven to commit any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating), the title and the prize shall be withdrawn.
9. All entries shall become the property of the DA and FAO.
10. Winning entries will be displayed during the culminating activities of the WFD Celebration on October 16, 2019 at the Liwasang Aurora Memorial Circle, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City. Best Posters will be awarded on the same event.
11. Winners of the Best Poster will receive a cash prize, trophy, and certificate of recognition.

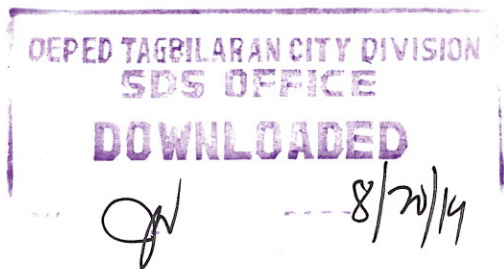

The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork.
