Along this line, we wish to request your school/ barangay/ civic organization/ business establishment to field in one (1) candidate to represent your entity.


Attached are the guidelines and timetable in connection with the 2019 Miss Alay Lakad canvassing and pre-pageant preparations that you need to be aware of.

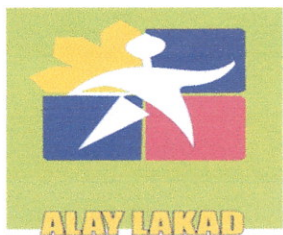

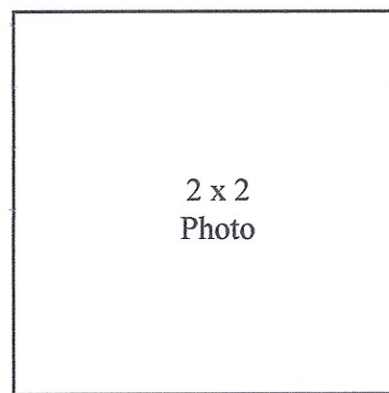

- The official candidate of the school, organization, institution, business establishment or barangay that she is representing, as certified by the head of the entity;
- Single, never been married, must not be a common-law wife or common-law husband, and must not have given birth;
- With pleasing personality; and
- Willing to take part in all activities as set by the 2019 Alay Lakad Executive and Miss Alay Lakad Committees.

GUIDELINES:

- The candidates are required to fill out their personal profile form upon registration.
- The candidates must attend practices and other pre-pageant activities.
- The candidates will be provided with 2019 Miss Alay Lakad official T-shirts by the Committee.
- The candidates are reminded to follow the assigned blockings and poses given by the choreographer during the production number, sportswear, and evening gown competitions.
- Since the pageant is a fundraiser, the final ranking for the Top 3 winners will be based solely on the results of the canvassing conducted on September 13, 2019 at the ICM Activity Center to be done by the 2019 Alay Lakad Finance Committee, in coordination with the JCI Chocolate Hills, and the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) staff.
- This schedule of canvassing shall be followed: First Canvassing - 12:00 p.m. and Second/Final Canvassing: 6:00 p.m.
- The 2019 Alay Lakad Finance Committee shall receive cash or managers check donations for the 2019 Miss Alay Lakad.
- The actual pageant and coronation will be on September 14, 2019, 2:00 in the afternoon, at the Island City Mall Activity Center.
- The special awards to be given:
 - Darling of the Social Media (depending on the number of shares on Facebook)
 - Miss Photogenic (to be judged by the official photographer)
 - Best in Production Number (to be judged based on projection, stage presence and overall performance)
 - Best in Sports Wear (to be judged, based on fitness, confidence, poise and grace, stage presence, and symmetry of face, figure, and legs)
 - Best in Gown (to be judged, based on fitness of the gown, class and elegance, poise and grace, stage presence, charm, and overall projection)
