DANCING (DANCESPORT) TRAINING WORKSHOP**

1. Per Memorandum Order No. 103 of the City Government of Tagbilaran, this Office announces the conduct of the City Council for Culture and Arts (CCCA) Dance Committee Basic Ballroom Dancing (Dancesport) Training Workshop on September 11-13, 2019 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Bohol Cultural Center.
2. The activity aims to:
  - Heighten awareness of the public and private elementary schools on dancesport.
  - Discover and develop skills among dancesports athletes and enthusiasts using the standards of the International Dancesport Federation
  - Provide lectures about ballroom dance and the correct steps in Latin and Modern Standard,
  - Prepare for dancesports competitions, and,
  - Sustain the love of dancing while promoting dancesports as the youth's diversion and preventive measure from drug abuse and petty crimes.
3. In this connection, you are directed to encourage the participation of :
  - Bonafide elementary, secondary and senior high school learners – 2 pairs per school, 1 pair each for the Modern Standard and Latin American from the public and private schools
  - Physically fit MAPEH teachers , 1 accompanying coach
  - Student participation shall be the schools official athletes for the upcoming City Meet on Sept. 26, 2019
4. Registration of the training is FREE, inclusive of lunch only per day. All participants must wear the proper training attire for the entire duration. There will be a teacher-coach to accompany the participating students. There are only 150 slots available and it would be a first-come first serve basis only.

BASIC BALLROOM DANCING (DANCESPORT) TRAINING WORKSHOP ON September 11-13, 2019

The City Government of Tagbilaran, through the City Council for Culture and the Arts (CCCA) – Dance Committee will conduct the **Basic Ballroom Dancing (Dancesport) Training Workshop** on **September 11-13, 2019 (Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday)**, from **8 a.m. to 12 noon and 1 to 5 p.m.** at the **Bohol Cultural Center, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.**

Realizing the potential importance of dancesport in these contemporary times, the activity is intended to:

- 1) Heighten awareness re dancesport in private and public elementary and secondary schools in the City of Tagbilaran;
- 2) Discover and develop skills among dancesport athletes and enthusiasts using a syllabus based on the standards outlined by the International Dancesport Federation;
- 3) Provide lectures about the nature and background of each ballroom dance and introduce the correct basic dance steps of Latin and Modern Standard;
- 4) Prepare for the school, district, division, regional, national, and even international athletic meet dancesport competitions; and
- 5) Sustain the love of dancing while promoting dancesport as the youth's diversion and preventive measure from drug abuse and petty crimes.

In this connection, you are directed to ensure the participation of the following:

- City Council for Culture and the Arts – Dance Committee officers and members and some Bohol Association of Dance Instructors (BADI) members;
- Bona fide elementary pupils and junior/senior high school students – two (2) pairs for every school, 1 pair each for the Modern Standard and Latin American disciplines, respectively - from the City's private and public schools; and
- Physically fit Music-Arts-Physical Education-Health (MAPEH) teachers, 1 accompanying coach/adviser in dancesport.
- Student-participants shall be the school's official athletes for the **upcoming City Meet 2019** on September 26, 2019.

Registration for the training is **FREE**, inclusive of lunch only per day for each **participant**. All participants must wear the proper training attire for the entire duration of the activity. There will be a **teacher-coach** who will accompany to the participating students. Confirmation of the actual number of participants shall be **done by the Office of City Mayor – City Events, Culture, and Arts Office (CECAO)** personnel. There are **150 slots available for the training** and it would be a first-come-first-serve basis only.
