

Greetings from CYWTAC Legazpi!

As a society, we cannot afford to postpone investing in children until they become adults. The best evidence supports the policy prescription: invest in the very young and improve basic learning and support in their development. This includes integrating play in childhood learning and supporting them if learning difficulties are being experienced. A great deal of research has concluded that play-based learning is genuinely and positively impactful on student learning and development. Beyond stimulating young minds to be receptive to learning, play is a necessary component of brain development for children.
