HARANAHAN

- **Guidelines:**
- The contest is open to all RCY Councils around the province of Bohol.
- Interested councils must pre – register their participation through a registration form to be provided by the organizing team. The said form must be passed on or before October 05, 2019 – Saturday, at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter - Red Cross Youth Office or emailed at redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com.
- Each council should only have one (1) band with a minimum of three (3) members and a maximum of five (5). The group should also consist of 40% Red Cross Youth (RCY) Volunteers.
- A registration fee of one hundred (100) pesos will be collected from each participating band.
- The contest will only cater five (5) councils on a First Come, First Serve basis.
- Each contestant is only given three (3) songs to perform.
- Contestants must provide their own instruments (strictly guitar and beatbox only) or they may perform in acapella. The songs can be in English, Filipino, Cebuano or a combination of these.
- The songs must be in the form of "HARANA". It must be in a mellow tune and most probably be in the love song genre.
- The contest will be on **October 12, 2019**, Saturday, after the Opening Ceremony of the Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2019.
- Sequence of performances will be determined before the contest proper through a draw by lot.

CONTEMPORARY DANCE COMPETITION

Guidelines:

- The contest is open to all RCY Councils around the province of Bohol.
- Interested councils must pre – register their participation through a registration form to be provided by the organizing team. The said form must be passed on or before October 05, 2019 – Saturday, at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter - Red Cross Youth Office or email at redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com.
- Each council should only have one (1) group consisting of four (4) to eight (8) members (e.g. actors, dancers, props men). It could be all boys, all girls or a combination of both. The group must also consist of at least 50% Red Cross Youth (RCY) Volunteers.
- The contest will only cater ten (10) councils on a First Come, First Serve basis.
- A registration fee of one hundred fifty (150) pesos will be collected from each participating band.
- The contestants will be given three (3) to five (5) minutes to perform their chosen song that would fit with the given theme.
 - *Note: Song must not offend the principles of Red Cross.*
- The contestants are also given one (1) minute to prepare and one (1) minute aftercare. Failure to do so will result to a 3 points deduction to the total score.
- Contestants may also bring their own props for the performance.
- The contest will be on **October 12, 2019**, Saturday, after the Opening Ceremony of the Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2019.
- Sequence of performances will be determined before the contest proper through a draw by lot.
- The contestants must arrive at the venue thirty (30) minutes before the start of **The Exposition**. Failure to do so will lead to automatic disqualification.

3. Only 20 participants, one from each council will be accepted for the contest.

II. GENERAL GUIDELINES/MECHANICS

1. The participants are invited to the Island City Mall- Activity Centre for the Quiz Bee Competition which will be held on **October 12, 2019**, Saturday.
2. Schedule:
 - a. Arrival of Contestants: **12:00-1:00 pm**
 - b. Contest Proper: **After the opening program of the Bohol Red Cross Youth Days 2019**
 - c. **Awarding: Right after the contest**
3. The participants are required to wear their RCY Council Shirt during the contest if there is or if none, any Red Cross Shirt will do.
4. Each council is required to have a pair of representatives. These two contestants must be an RCY and will be together during the contest.
5. The coverage of the questions is the Red Cross history, facts, concepts and latest events.
6. The quiz is composed of three categories, easy, average and difficult. Each category is composed of 10 questions.
7. The scoring for each corresponding category are the following:
 - a. Easy Round- each question is worth 5 point Total Score: 50 pts
 - b. Average Round- each question is worth 10 points Total Score: 100 pts
 - c. Difficult Round- each question is worth 15 points. Total Score: 150 ptsOverall Perfect Score: 300 pts
8. Time Allotment:

- a. Easy Round- 20 seconds/question
 - b. Average Round- 25 seconds/question
 - c. Difficult Round- 30 seconds/question
9. The contestant will be given the materials needed for answering such as boards, chalk or marker and eraser.
 10. Before the quiz master will start, the contestants are ask to raise their chalk or marker then as the quiz master is done reading the question, the contestant will start writing as the quiz master will say "GO!".
 11. The contestant will then raise their boards as they hear the bell rings which signify that the time is up.
 12. The assigned organizer will count the correct answers and tally it in the board or excel prepared. He/she will also be the one to monitor the total score of each category.
 13. Cheating is greatly prohibited. Once caught will be disqualified.
 14. Wrong spelling is wrong.
 15. In case of tie scores, another round will be added to the two contestants to break it. The time and corresponding score will depend on the quiz master. The quiz master will announce the ruling of the tiebreaker round before the quiz starts.
 16. As the total scores are computed, the first 3 winners will be announced.
 17. The proper awarding and giving of certificates of recognition will be during the RCY program.

EDITORIAL WRITING



Guidelines:

EDITORIAL WRITING expresses the opinion of whatever the writer feels in relation to the present occasion. It explain and interpret the news, to put it in on its proper perspective, to analyse it, to draw conclusions from that analysis and to persuade the readers to follow a course of action that the writer believes is for the public good regardless of party interests involved.

I. REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

1. The Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter- Red Cross Youth Editorial Writing Competition is open to all RCY Councils in the province of Bohol. Unlimited participant each council can join and must be a member of MAAB (Membership Fund with Accident Assistance Benefits).
2. Interested councils must pre-register their participation in a registration form given by the organizing team. There is no registration fee.
3. The deadline of the submission of the registration form will be on **October 5, 2019** at the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter- Red Cross Youth Office or email us at redcrossyouthbohol@gmail.com.

II. EDITORIAL WRITING COMPETITION PROPER

1. The participants will be invited to Island City Mall Activity Center for the Opening of the Exposition which will be held on October 12, 2019.
2. The participant is required to wear any Red Cross Shirt.
3. The editorial must be in the type of Editorial of Commendation, Appreciation, or Tribute. It praises, commends, or pays tribute to a person or organization that has performed some worthwhile projects or deeds, or accomplishment.
4. The participants are required to witness the following activities; Exposition- October 12, 2019 at Island City Mall and Gukod- October 13, 2019 (see attached guidelines for Gukod), for these will be their basis on their composition.
5. The editorial must be an original composition and not copied from any source.
6. Three printed copies must be provided to be given to the organizer of the contest one hour before the opening of the program for Mr. RCY on October 20, 2019.
7. Awarding of winners will be held at Island City Mall Activity Center on October 20, 2019.

IV. JUDGING OF WINNERS

1. Chosen experts will be the members of the Board of Judges.
2. Criteria of judging will be based on:
 - a. **Technical – 40%**
 - Uses lead paragraph that contains news peg and the general stand of the writer.
 - Presents arguments that are based on facts.
 - Cites sources of facts to add credibility to the arguments raised.
 - Uses a strong and thought-provoking title or headline.
 - Shows logical reasoning.
 - Observes the rules of grammar and syntax.
 - Utilizes transitions properly.
 - b. **Content – 50%**
 - Presents the general stand of the writer in the lead.
 - Utilizes facts from interviews, documents review, data analyses and other reliable sources.
 - Displays evidence of the writers' knowledge and understanding of issues/problems.
 - Reflects clarity of the message and can influence public opinion.
 - Arguments presented in the body logically support the writer's stand.
 - c. **Ethics – 10%**
 - Observes ethical and professional standards for journalism (fairness, relevance, accuracy, originality).
 - Cites sources and observes copyright laws.

V. GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The literary piece must be an original work that is wholly conceptualized and composed by the participant. Composition which copied the content of existing works will automatically be disqualified, even if they are rendered in a different style.
2. Major winners give PRC Bohol Chapter RCY the authority to use their literary piece in publication, promotional use and other purposes deemed necessary with proper and due acknowledgment and recognition of the participant.
3. RCY organization reserves the right to withdraw any award at any time should the participant violate any of the rules and regulations of the contest or if the RCY organization deems, in any way, that granting the participant the award will damage the reputation of the organization.
4. Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations shall automatically disqualify the participant/s.
5. By submitting the signed entry form, participant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the contest.

NEWS WRITING or NEWS STYLE is the particular prose style used for news reporting as well as in news items that air on radio and television. News style encompasses not only vocabulary and sentence structure, but also the way in which stories present the information in terms of relative importance, tone, and intended audience.

5. The news must be an original composition and not copied from any source.
6. Three printed copies must be provided to be given to the organizer of the contest one hour before the opening of the program for Mr. RCY on October 20, 2019.
7. Awarding of winners will be held at Island City Mall Activity Center on October 20, 2019.
