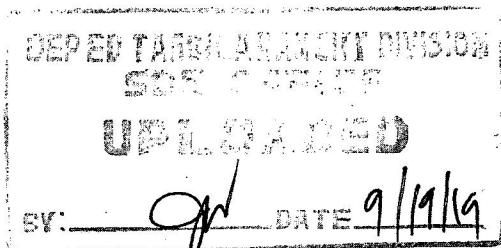

Greetings from Tagbilaran City Host Lions Club...


