

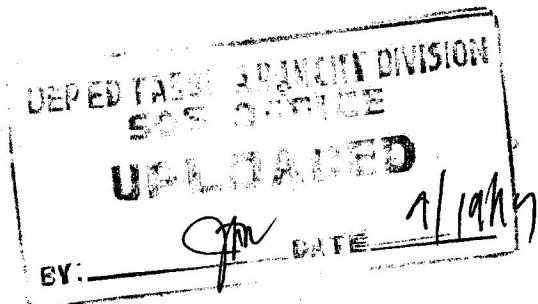

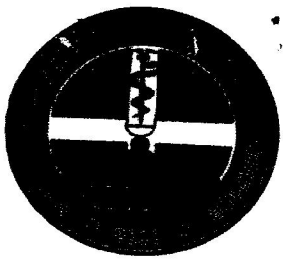
**ONSITE ESSAY WRITING AND POSTER MAKING CONTEST**

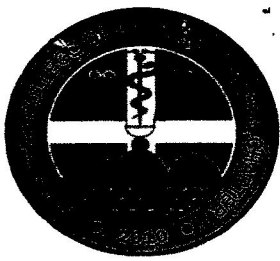
- 1<sup>st</sup> place - P 3, 000 + Certificate + Trophy to the school

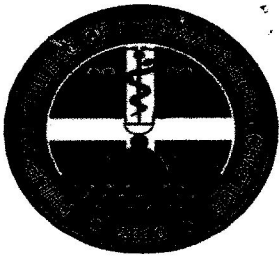
## I. Guidelines and Criteria for Poster Making Contest

2. Upon registration, each contestant will submit a certification from the school principal stating the name of the contestant and the coach as the official entry in the competition.
3. Contestant should wear complete school uniform with valid ID upon registration.
4. Each contestant shall use only the art materials that will be provided to them.
5. Contestants shall be given three (3) hours to finish their art work.
6. All winning entries shall be considered property of the organization and will be used by the organization for publication and any other legal purpose.
7. The decision of the judges selected by the organization shall be final and irrevocable.
8. Criteria of the Poster Making Contest:

a. Relevance to theme	-	30%
b. Creativity	-	30%
c. Visual Impact	-	25%
d. Originality	-	<u>15%</u>
TOTAL =		100%
9. The winners will be announced after the duration of the competition.
10. Relatives of the organizer up to the third degree of consanguinity or affinity are not eligible to join.

## I. Guidelines and Criteria for Onsite Essay writing Contest

1. Each contestant with one (1) official coach should register on the day of the contest and they should attend the lecture forum prior to the contest and contestants should be at their assigned seat when the contest starts.
2. Upon registration, each contestant will submit a certification from the school principal stating the name of the contestant and the coach as the official entry in the competition.
3. Contestant should wear complete school uniform with valid ID upon registration.
4. Each contestant shall be provided with two (2) black pens and four (4) sheets of papers to write for their piece. Additional sheets of paper will be provided and be used by contestant duly pre signed by the authorized facilitator and all sheets of paper will be submitted together with the final piece after given time.
5. The essay piece shall contain a minimum of 250 words and maximum of 500 words.
6. English shall be used as medium in writing the essay piece.
7. Contestants shall be given one (1) hour to develop and write their composition.
8. All winning entries shall be considered property of the organization and will be used by the organization for publication and any other legal purpose.
9. The decision of the judges selected by the organization shall be final and irrevocable.
10. Criteria of the Onsite Essay Writing Contest:
 

a. Substance or content	-	40%
b. Relevance to theme	-	20%
c. Organization or Clarity of ideas	-	20%
d. Mechanics	-	20%
<b>TOTAL =</b>		<b>100%</b>
