6. present a wholesome, family-oriented entertainment that will truly inspire, inspire and inspire students



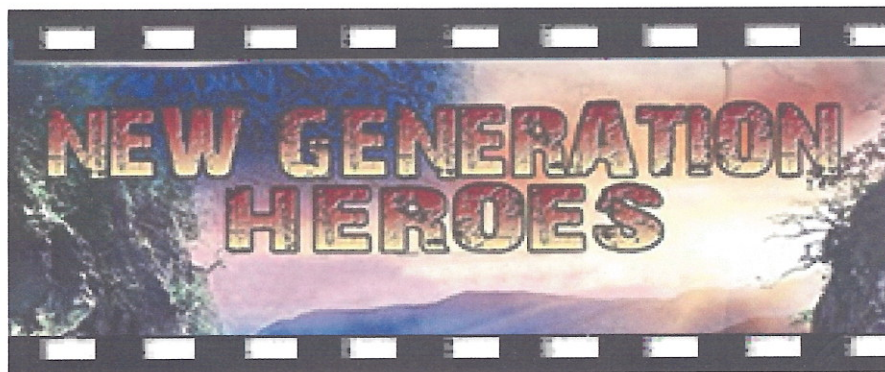

## SYNOPSIS

The film features the story of four individuals that tackles the world of teaching in all its forms namely, Ms. Salvation Fajardo a retired, well-respected and well-loved teacher of 40 years played by Anita Linda. She decided to work overseas in an effort to give her family in the Philippines a better life — tuition for her 2 children and the construction of their home. Little did she know that her husband was using the money she sent home on alcohol and gambling and her eldest child, Tony, was a drug addict. Her son, Tony, was killed by the police as part of the government's operation "tokhang" and this became her motivation to leave her job in Korea and decide to come back home to the Philippines.
