

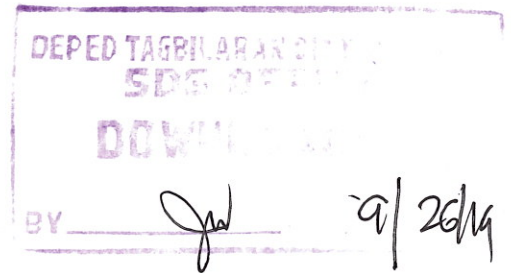

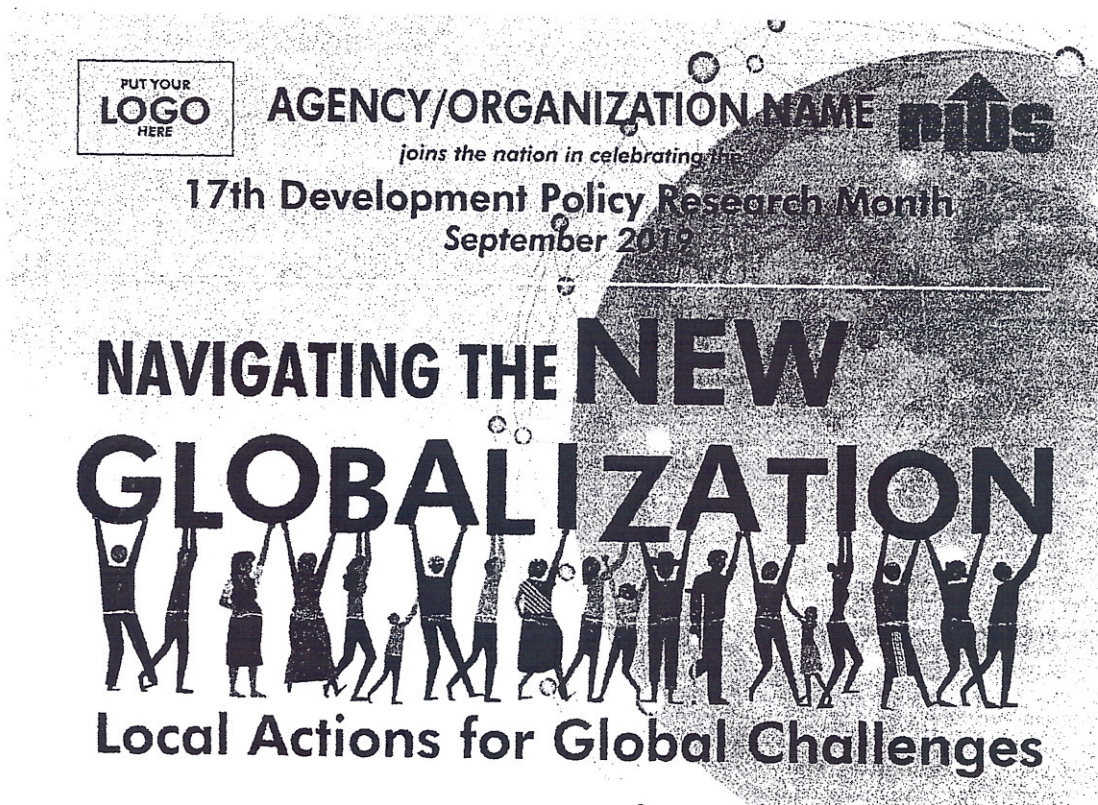

2. Open the JPEG file using a photo editor application such as Adobe Photoshop.
