

SUBJECT: HALF-DAY HOLIDAY IN THE AFTERNOON OF FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2019 IN VIEW OF THE NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATION

It may be recalled that pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 (s. 2011) and Republic Act No. 10743 (s. 2016), the country is celebrating National Teachers' Month starting September 5 until October 5, 2019 and the National Teachers' Day on October 5, 2019, respectively. In fact, on August 20, 2019, Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Secretary Eduardo M. Ano issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-139 directing All Provincial Governors, City Mayors, Municipal Mayors, BARMM Chief Minister, BARMM Minister of Local Government, DILG Regional Directors, and others concerned "to promote a culture of gratitude to Filipino teachers" through an advocacy of teacher appreciation among local government unit (LGU) employees, as a way to express gratitude for the hard work of our teachers in helping shape the future of Filipino learners."

Moreover, Secretary Leonor Briones of the Department of Education (DepEd) welcomed the celebration of the National Teachers' Month (NTM) by highlighting the "indispensability" of teachers – especially in keeping the "humanistic aspects of education" in the midst of digital age, putting a premium on the crucial role of teachers as guides, managers, and listeners amid technological innovations and other emerging trends in education" with the theme "Gurong Pilipino: Handa sa Makabagong Pagbabago."

In this regard, as we in the City Government of Tagbilaran have a high regard for education stakeholders and partners who "believe in the importance of teachers in developing globally minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation," the undersigned City Mayor of Tagbilaran hereby declares a **half-day holiday in the afternoon of Friday, October 4, 2019 for all the Public School Teachers in the Tagbilaran City Schools Division to have the time off to enjoy the rest of the day, to make it more meaningful.**
