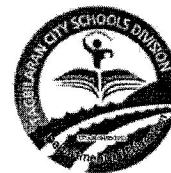

## PROVINCIAL CHEMISTRY OLYMPIAD 2019

### GUIDELINES

#### A. THE CONTESTANTS

1. All participating schools must confirm their attendance on or before October 30, 2019 (Wednesday).
2. Each school will send a maximum of three (3) students currently enrolled in Grades 9, 10, 11, or 12. The coach must also be employed in the same school.
3. The participants shall fill up the registration forms before the competition starts. A registration fee of PHP 200.00 per participant is required.
4. Students must be in their proper school uniform with their valid IDs on the day of the competition.

#### B. THE COVERAGE

1. Questions include topics from high school General Chemistry, basic Organic Chemistry (nomenclature of hydrocarbons and functional groups to be specified), and basic Biochemistry.

#### C. THE MECHANICS

1. Registration of participating students and coaches will start at 7:30 AM until 8:30 AM at the following venues: for Cebu - Science and Mathematics Education Department Audio-Visual Room (SMED-AVR), University of San Carlos - Talamban Campus, Cebu City; for Bohol - (rooms to be announced), Bohol Wisdom School, Tagbilaran City. Participants and coaches must register themselves during the indicated period.
2. Prior to the examination, the participants must place their valuables on the area provided by the examiners.
3. Scratch papers and periodic table of elements shall be provided by the organizers to the participants.
4. The competition consists of a 60-item written multiple choice examination. The participants shall finish answering the examination for two (2) hours. All examination sheets and other materials provided by the organizers shall be submitted afterwards.
5. Strictly NO EXTENSION TO LATECOMERS.
6. Participants shall bring their own calculator, pen, liquid eraser, pencil, etc. Inspection shall be done prior to the start of the examination. Pocket and programmable calculators are strictly prohibited.
7. Each item is worth one point.
8. Questions concerning the examination shall be addressed only to the proctor.
9. Strictly NO CHEATING and NOT TALKING TO OTHER PARTICIPANTS.
10. The ten highest scoring participants shall represent the province in the Regional Chemistry Olympiad 2019 on November 23, 2019 at University of San Carlos - Talamban Campus, Cebu City. Announcement of qualifiers shall be done within an hour after the examination period.
