The Academic Festival X

Every year, UPKB holds activities that adhere to our objectives of promoting Bol-anon culture and the development of our home province. Our biggest event is the **Academic Festival (AcadFest)**, a series of academics-based competitions for Bol-anon high school students.

The **AcadFest** aims to develop the skills and talents of Bol-anon students, give outstanding Bol-anon youth the recognition they rightfully deserve, and to help Bol-anon youth become aware of current issues, trends, and challenges which may play a role in the contributions they will make to society.

Last 2016, UPKB became part of the UP Sanlahi Alliance, a university-wide congregation of provincial, regional, and ethno-linguistic organizations in UP Diliman. UP Sanlahi Alliance holds an annual academic-related event called *PotataSanlahi* – through which students are sent to are given the chance to compete with schools from all over the country, held in UP Diliman, Quezon City.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Academic Festival X is open to all high school students (senior high school and junior high school) and graders 4 to 6. Any school may send representatives to AcadFest X provided that they are currently enrolled for S. Y. 19-20 in the said school. Contestants must be able to present proof of enrollment (e.g. school ID or certification from principal with photo) when the need arises.
- Only students listed in the reply form for AcadFest X submitted by the school to UP Kadugong Bol-anon may participate or represent their school in their corresponding events. In the case that a student listed in the registration form will not be able to participate/attend in his/her event due to illness, the school may replace said student with another currently enrolled student upon presentation of medical certificates. Reasons other than illness will be decided on a case-to-case basis by the Technical Committee of AcadFest X.
- All contestants must be at the venue at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of their corresponding event. Failure to do so may be grounds for disqualification.
- Judges' decisions are rendered FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.
- All participants and their supporters are encouraged to attend the Opening Ceremony on December 18 except for the participants of the Great High School Debate and their coaches. There will be a roll call of contingent or "show of force" per school. The participants and supporters are also highly encouraged to attend the Awarding Ceremony on December 20 for the same reason.
- All rules, regulations, mechanics, and guidelines in this manual are subject to change. Schools will be informed whenever such changes occur.
- Schedule of events may be changed in the case of unexpected situations that may occur. Advisers and participants will be duly informed as soon as possible.
- Each place garnered by a participant/team for each component event will be awarded with corresponding points which will be tallied on the last day to determine the AcadFest X Over-all Winners.

PROTESTS AND COMPLAINTS

- Any violation of the mechanics, rules, and regulations for any or all events of AcadFest X observed by the advisers must be raised to the Technical Committee or Grievance Desk of said event up to the day after the event.
- Only the contestants are allowed to complain. However, protests will be entertained only if the adviser approaches the Technical Committee in the most civil and subtle way to avoid any unnecessary commotion.
- The Technical Committee reserves the prerogative to either disclose the protest or to conceal it from the audience.



ACADEMIC RACE

An amazing race-type competition seeking to test the contestants' abilities in various subject matters and their skill in formulating strategies

MECHANICS

THE PARTICIPANTS

- Each participating school shall be represented by one team **ONLY**. The team shall be composed of three students: one 8th GRADER, one 9th GRADER, and one 10th GRADER.
- Each team member is required to wear the **PE uniform** of their school. *
- Participants are not allowed to bring the following while competing in the race:
 1. Extra Money
 2. Private Vehicle(s)
 3. Gadgets (e.g. cellphone, laptop, calculator)
 4. Bags

They are allowed to bring only the following: water, towel/handkerchief, ballpen/pencil.

- In relation to Rule number 3, each team shall be given a fixed amount of money for their and the marshal's expenses during the race. Asking for money and rides from other people while the race is ongoing is also **NOT** allowed. The contestants shall handle the money for the whole duration of the race.
- **Violating rules 3 and 4 will result in disqualification.**

THE RACE

- The race shall have a total of 6 stations, namely the **GENERAL KNOWLEDGE** station, the **SOCIAL SCIENCES** station, the **SCIENCE** station, the **LITERATURE** station, the **MATHEMATICS** station, and an **UNKNOWN** station. **

- The stations are located in different parts of Tagbilaran City. The first shall be at Island City Mall. Clues for the locations of the other stations shall be given ahead in order for the team to strategize on which station to take on first.
- The nature of the challenges at each station varies from one station to another. There will be station heads (members of the Acad Race Steering Committee) at each station to oversee the challenges. Each team shall be given 15 MINUTES (answering time) to accomplish the challenge in each station.
- If a team successfully accomplishes the challenge, they shall move on to the next station they wish to take. However, if a team fails to accomplish the challenge, the team shall be given a penalty ticket with the corresponding penalty time signed by the station head. The penalty time varies, depending on the station or on the number of correct answers the team managed to give and shall be added onto the team's total time of completion of the race.
- For QUESTION AND ANSWER type station/s, each team needs to correctly answer only 50% of the total number of questions (i.e. total number of questions=10, required number of correct answers=5). The penalty times for different sets of given correct answers are tabulated below:

NUMBER OF CORRECT ANSWERS

- For HANDS-ON station/s, if a team fails to get the correct answer or do the required task, a penalty time of 10 minutes applies. It should be noted that the penalty time starts **ONLY** after the 15-minute answering time. If a team submits their answer/s way before the answering time elapses but fails to give the correct answer or obtain the required number of points, the team shall acquire a total penalty of (time remaining from the answering time) + (penalty time). Emphasizing that the team will not anymore be held dormant in the station wherein they weren't able to accomplish the said task.
- Each team shall be given a total of 3 chances for their answers to be checked and this is already included in the 15 minute time allotment for the station.
- Each team shall be accompanied by a *marshal*.
- The team who finishes the race in the least amount of time will be declared the winner of the UP Kadugong Bol-anon Acad Race X.

THE MARSHAL

Description:

- Individuals recruited by the Acad Race Steering Committee.
- They are not participants in the Acad Race.
- They are not affiliated with the school he/she will be handling.

Functions:

- Accompanies the team.
- Checker. The teams **SHALL** approach the marshal (NOT the station head) when they want their answers to be checked.
- Timer. Times the answering time.
- Penalty Ticket Holder. The marshal will hold the penalty tickets given by the station heads whenever the team acquires penalties
- Raises violations of the team.
- Updates the audience at ICM.

Notes:

*If not applicable, the participants should wear jogging pants or sports attire.

**The stations may not be in order.



BRAINSCAN

A quiz type competition about academic subjects and current events

MECHANICS

- There will be 10 questions for each category and each question for every category will be read twice.
- Tag boards **MUST** be raised when allotted time expires, and put down when told.
- Multiple-choice questions must be answered with letters only while questions without choices must be answered with the correct word or phrase. Correct spelling should be strictly followed.
- The scores of the participants from the three rounds will be added at the end of all the rounds to get the total score. The group that garners the highest total score will be declared the champion.
- Any form of cheating is not allowed. The audience must refrain from making any form of signal that would hint the contestants the right answer. Once caught, the contestant/s will be disqualified.
- The questions for each round category will be based on the following: Current events, Pop Culture, General Information, Natural Science, Mathematics, Social Science (Economics, Geography, History, Politics), Language, Arts and Literature

ESSAY WRITING & PAGSUSULAT NG SANAYSAY

A contest that will challenge the competitors' ability in writing an essay regarding current social issues and the like

MECHANICS

- The essay shall be written on the spot and be based on a given topic.
- Each school must only have one participant for Essay Writing, and one participant for Pagsusulat ng Sanaysay.
- For Essay, the composition shall be written in English (English Category).
- For Pagsusulat ng Sanaysay, the composition shall be written in Filipino (Filipino Category).
- Entries shall be identified using their respective numbers of the participating student writers.
- Contestants must bring their own black pens.
- Entries must have a minimum of 1 000 words.
- A time limit of one hour and thirty minutes will be allotted for the whole contest.
- Contestants who will arrive late will still be allowed to join the contest, but no time extension will be given.

EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING (ENGLISH & FILIPINO)

A contest that will test the participants' competence in delivering an unrehearsed, on-impulse speech of their stand about a given theme

MECHANICS

- Each school must only have one participant for Extemporaneous Speaking (ENGLISH category).
- Each school must only have one participant for Extemporaneous Speaking (FILIPINO category).
- Only one topic will be given for all contestants.

Timeframe:

Organization of Thought	1 minute
Delivery	3 minutes
Content	2 minutes
Wrap Up (signal will be given)	1 minute

Signal will be given at the 2-min and 3-min mark

Criteria:

GREAT HIGH SCHOOL DEBATE

The 26th Great High School Debate Tournament will test the contestants' ability to defend and win over an argument on certain issues that are relevant or of public interest

MECHANICS

- Each school is required to send a team composed of three members.
- For this year's debate competition, the format to be used is Asian Parliamentary Debate Format: http://debatepedia.idebate.org/en/index.php/Portal:Asian_Parliamentary_Debate
- There will be elimination rounds held simultaneously to determine the top teams that will qualify for the semi-finals. This will be done on **December 18, 2019** before the final competition.
- The competing teams for the elimination rounds will be determined randomly. A random selection program will be conducted by the adjudicators of the Great High School Debate.
- The selection of competing teams for the last elimination round will be through power matching; that is depending on the team and individual members' score standing.
- Motions will be given on the day of the feat; a grace period of fifteen minutes will be allotted to the teams for the speech preparation.
- The top four teams in the semi-final round will qualify for the final round.
- The team with the highest garnered score (team and individual speakers' scores) will be declared winner.



MINDMAZE

A competition that challenges the students' logic and puzzle-solving skills

MECHANICS

General Guidelines

- Mind maze is open to all secondary schools. Each school can send only one team of three students.
- The contest will be held on December 19, 2019. All teams must be present 15 minutes before the time stated for the registration.
- The participants are only allowed to bring ball pen or pencil. Tag boards, chalks, and erasers will be provided.
- There are four categories of questions namely math and logic, abstract reasoning, riddles and mystery questions.
- The quiz contest is divided into an elimination round and a final round.
- Every question will be read twice.
- The team can begin answering even if the quiz master is not yet finished reading the question.
- Timer starts after the question has been read twice. A bell marks the time is over and the teams must raise their tag boards with or without answers.

Elimination Round

- The elimination round consists of three rounds based on the degree of difficulty of the question: easy, average and difficult rounds. The easy and average rounds are composed of 10 questions each while the difficult is composed of 5 questions.
- Every question in the easy round is worth 10 points and has a time limit of 15 seconds; and average round question is worth 20 points with a time limit of 30 seconds; and a difficult round question is worth 30 points with the limit of 60 seconds.
- The 5 teams with the highest scores will proceed to the final round.

Final Round

- The final round shall consist of 20 questions, 5 questions from each category.
- The flow of the game in the final round will follow "betting" format. For every question, teams must bet 5 points or any higher amount divisible by 5.
- The points accumulated in the elimination round will be used as betting points.
- The leading team has the power to choose the category of the question.
- Bets should be placed on the provided tag board after the leading team chose the category and the difficulty of the question is revealed. 10 seconds are allotted as betting time.
- Teams with correct/wrong answers will earn/lose points depending on the amount they bet and the degree of difficulty of the question.
- For easy questions, the team with correct/wrong answer will earn/lose the amount they bet (1xbet). For average questions, the team with correct/wrong answer will earn/lose twice the amount they bet (2xbet). For difficulty questions, the team with correct/wrong answer will earn/lose thrice the amount they bet (3xbet).
 - Example: The team's current score is 200. If the team bets 10 points for a difficult question and they got the correct answer, their score will become 230. The additional 30 points is based on the bet (10 point) and the difficulty, $10 \times 3 = 30$. If the team got the wrong answer, their score will become 170.
- There is no negative score.
- If in case the team has zero points or has no points to bet, they may use one of their teammates as their bet. The name of their teammate must be written on the tag board. In this case, teams with correct answers will retain their teammate plus an additional 5 points (regardless of the difficulty of the question), while incorrect answers will eliminate the person from the team.
- When only two team members are left in the team, either of them may be placed as a bet. If they get the correct answer, the bet will be retained, and the teammate previously eliminated will be back in the game. If they get a wrong answer, the bet will be out of the team.
- When the team has lost two of its members, the remaining member will have to be the bet. If he/she gets the correct answer, he/she can choose one teammate to return to the team. But in case of a wrong answer, the team will be totally eliminated from the game.
- The team with the highest score after the final round shall be declared the champion of the UPKB MindMaze X. In case of a tie, a clincher round shall be held.

Clincher Round

- A clincher round shall be held in the event that there is a tie in the elimination and finals round.
- The clincher round will be in a “do or die” format, where teams will be asked a question and the first team to get an answer right will be the winner of the round. In case no team get the correct answer, another question will be asked until a winner is determined.

Medallion of Immortality

- During the final round, three special questions hold the Medallion of Immortality. To acquire this, the team should get the correct answer to the special question.
- Each special question grants a medallion to the teams that answered correctly, such that a team can have multiple (maximum of three) medallions at a single time.
- The Medallion of Immortality has the power to shield the team from losing points or a teammate. The team has the freedom of choosing when to use the Medallion of Immortality, but it can only be used ONCE. If the team decides to use the Medallion of Immortality, the team should place it as a bet together with the points the team wants to bet. If the team gets the wrong answer, the medallion will take effect and will prevent the team from losing points. If the team gets the correct answer, the team gets the additional points and the medallion wears off.



PHOTO JOURNALISM

This contest will test the contestants' artistry and creativity by producing photographs and a corresponding caption that wholly capture the Academic Festival theme

MECHANICS

- Only one (1) representative per school is allowed to join the said contest.
- The theme of the photo contest will be announced during the day of the event.
- Photos must be submitted not later than 4 PM during the day of the contest for it will be uploaded on the UP Kadugong Bol-anon AcadFest Facebook Page.
- For judging, 30% of the score will be from votes or "likes" garnered by the said entry and 70% will come from the judges' verdict.

Overall Impact	10%

POSTER MAKING

This contest will test the contestants' artistry and creativity by creating posters that wholly captures the Academic Festival theme

MECHANICS

- Each participating school must be represented by one (1) student.
- The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the given theme.
- The participant will be provided one 1/4 size illustration board to be used in the contest.
- ONLY pastel coloring materials and pencil should be used as a medium in the contest.
- It is strictly prohibited to bring draft sketch during the contest proper.
- A draw will be done before the contest proper to distribute the entry numbers to the participants. Entry numbers will be used to avoid bias.
- The order of the entry numbers will be used as the order in presenting the poster/ work.
- The participant will be given 2 hours to complete the poster and 3 minutes only to explain and present their poster/work.
- Questions regarding the mechanics and guidelines will not be entertained during the contest proper. Questions must be addressed before the contest will start.
