**GOVERNMENT & COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP AND

1. A Job Fair and symposium on Dualtech scholarship program to interested Grade 12 students from the public schools in Tagbilaran City will be conducted on **December 10, 2019, DCPNHS Gymnasium** at 3:00 – 5:00 PM. Only male Grade 12 students are eligible for Dualtech scholarships. Interested male students should bring their parent/guardian during the orientation.

Expenses relative to and in the conduct of this Government & Community Partnership and Local Stakeholders Convergence shall be chargeable to Partnership & Linkages and Local Stakeholders Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
