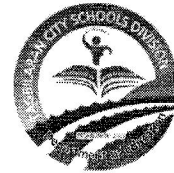

1. In consonance with the mandate of RA 9850 otherwise known as Arnis De Mano to be Our National Sport and National Martial Arts and cognizant with Palarong Pambansa Technical Guidelines, this office hereby announces the conduct of the **Arnis Training and Accreditation of Athletes, Coaches, Trainor's, and Technical Officials on December 16-19, 2019 at the New City Gym at the back of the City Health Office.**

3. The activity is sponsored by the City Government of Tagbilaran in partnership with Dep Ed - Tagbilaran City Division in collaboration of Philippine Eskrima Kali Arnis Federation (PECAF).
