Qualifications of Campers

- Girls**
- Must be registered Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scout as of March 31, 2020
 - Must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
 - Must have earned at least one (1) badge under the Eight-Point Challenge
 - Must have attended troop/district camps
- Adults**
- Must be registered Troop Leader as of March 31, 2020
 - Must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
 - Must know and understand her girls
 - Must know the basics of First Aid
 - Must have attended the Basic Course and Outdoor Leadership Course

Participants must be screened and be given the needed pre-camp training in school during Girl Scouting time on Fridays.

Camp Fee and Inclusions

Seven Hundred Pesos (P700.00) per camper to cover for program materials, badges, souvenir bag, event t-shirt, and tour.

Camp registration fee, and transportation/travelling expenses of the delegates may be charged against Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), District share of SMFC tickets, and local and other sources of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The campers will experience the following exciting and fun filled activities:

Dancing, Handcraft, Obstacle Games, Sessions on WAGGGS Special Programs, Tour, Food Fest, Songs and Cheers, Chum Hunting, Scouts Own, and Campfire.

The campers/contingents are expected to arrive at the campsite **within the afternoon of Thursday, February 27 until the morning of Friday, February 28 not later than 7:00 AM** complete with packed meals, and all the things needed for the camping.

The Parade on February 28 will start at 8:30 in the morning to be followed by the Opening Ceremony.

Confirmation and Pre-Registration of Campers

Confirmation and pre-registration of campers is **on or before January 31, 2020**.

Slots of districts who will not confirm on the deadline will be given as additional slot to other districts interested to send more girls.
