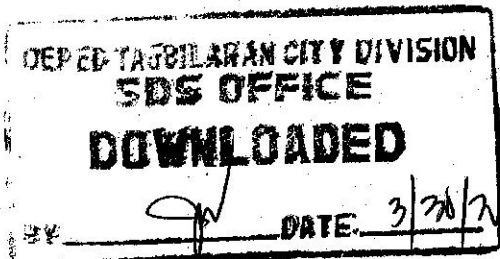

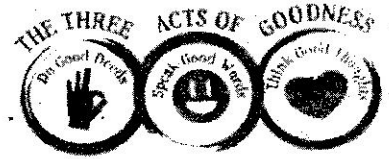

The rising global situation about COVID-19 Pandemic has caused a lot of community concerns which most of the companies has stopped their operations; government imposed community quarantine and lockdown of certain islands; and restrictions of inbound and outbound flights which affects most of the citizens nationwide. This health threat is developing each day as the number of cases arise.

In line with this, we regret to inform you that we have to cancel this year's TAG Awarding for Outstanding Students of DepEd Region 7 because of the following reasons:

1. The FGS foundation main office is located in Manila. This is the main funding organization that provides budget, logistics and technical support for the TAG awarding project. Since Manila have declared enhanced community quarantine, which also prohibits inbound and outbound transactions and operations of airports and seaports, it has become challenging for us to get the logistics and ask for technical assistance on time. These logistics includes certificates, medals and other collaterals.
2. There would be no moving-up ceremony among DepEd schools in region VII. Therefore, no legitimate documentation can be incurred in our end. It is a requirement for our foundation to appear in the moving up ceremony.

3. As per Executive Order memo in our company, we'll have to stop operation by March 19, 2020 and will resume until further notice as soon as the COVID-19 situation will be controlled.

We did attempt to come up with an alternative date or solution but we were thinking that this would be too impractical for both parties at such short notice.

We would like to apologize for the cancellation of this awarding, especially to those outstanding student awardees who anticipated to receive this certain award. Unfortunately, these were circumstances which were made beyond our control.
