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3. In preparation for the conduct of the dry run, the following activities must be followed:

July 13-17, 2020 - Preparation of Quarter 1, Week 1 Printed Module.

The template for the Module can be secured from Dr. Neolita S. Sarabia.

July 20-24, 2020 - Quality Assurance of the Prepared Printed Module.

The School Quality Assurance Team composed of Master Teachers and School LR Coordinator will conduct initial evaluation of the printed module.

The quality assured printed module (with attached certification from the School Quality Assurance Team) will be submitted to the concerned Education Program Supervisor for the second phase of quality assurance as to content then to the Education Program Supervisor (LR) for the technical aspect.

July 27-31, 2020- Reproduction of Printed Modules and Conduct of Orientation of Parents of Learners in the Chosen Section

The expenses relative to the reproduction of the printed modules at the schools can be charged against School MOOE/Local funds while that of the Community Learning Centers (CLCs) can be charged against Division MOOE.


An orientation to parents of the identified sample section will be conducted to be led by the Principal and the teachers.

August 3-7, 2020 - Conduct of the Dry Run

A Feedback Form on the conduct of the Dry Run from the Learners, Parents, Teachers, and Principals will be developed by a committee composed of Dr. Neolita S. Sarabia, (Mrs.) Esther L. Cagas, and (Mrs.) Liza E. Maquiling.

August 10-14, 2020 - Evaluation of the Conduct of the Dry Run and Submission of Report
