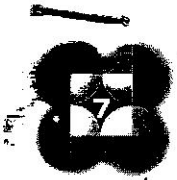

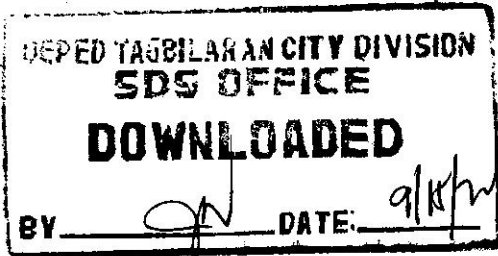

This event aims to create a dynamic environment for the new researchers and research institutions in the region to undertake basic research and to facilitate the exchange of ideas.

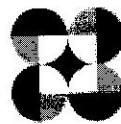
