

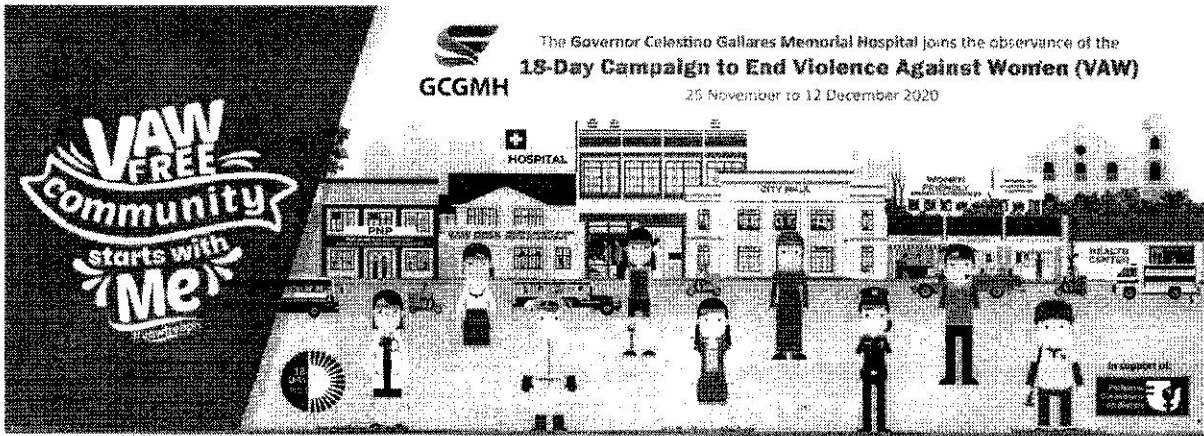

Awarding of Digital Poster-making Contest Winners & Raffles

DIGITAL

POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

- The digital poster making contest is open to all Boholanos. It is divided into three categories:
 - GCGMH Personnel Category
 - Community (c/o MSWO/CSWO) Category
 - Public and Private High School Students Category
- The poster making contest aims to promote wide awareness on the campaign to "End Violence Against Women and Children" (VAWC-Free Philippines)
- The poster should be made in any digital platform the artist prefer (Photoshop, Powerpoint, Paint, etc), the size of which is 15" x 20". The file must be saved in jpg or png format. Originality and clarity of the poster must be strictly observed.
- All entries must be submitted to gcmhwcpu2020@qmsil.com on or before November 23, 2020 11:59PM with the subject DIGITAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST ENTRY. The submission must include the following information details:
 - Complete Name of Artists (two members per entry)
 - Office (for GCGMH Category)
 - Municipality/City (for Community Category)
 - School (Public and Private High School Students Category)
 - Contact Number
 - Short Description of the artwork (100 to 200 words only)
- The poster will be rated by the panel of judges (70%) and online votes (30%)
- A panel of judges will be formed composed of individuals who are experts on arts, communication, and VAW advocacy. Judges will use the following criteria for scoring the poster: Message/Relevance 30%, Originality/Creativity 25%, Visual Appeal 25% and Design/Composition 20%.
- All entries will be featured on the Opening Program of GCGMH 18-day Campaign Against VAWC and will be posted on GCGMH Public Health Unit page on November 25, 2020. Casting of Online Votes will start on November 25, 2020 to December 9, 2020 11:59PM. Only "Heart" reaction will be counted as a vote.
- The top 3 winners for *each category* will receive the following prizes:
 - 1st Place Winner = Plaque of Recognition, Grocery Pack, Health Pack & Freebies
 - 2nd Place Winner = Certificate of Recognition, Grocery Pack & Health Pack
 - 3rd Place Winner = Certificate of Recognition, Grocery Pack & Health Pack
- The winners will be notified and will be announced in the GCGMH Public Health Unit page.
- The decision of the judges and the committee in relation the process and outcome of the contest is final and irrevocable.
- All submitted entries will be deemed property of GCGMHWCPU.
