**THE USE OF QUICK RESPONSE (QR) CODED CONTACT TRACING
SYSTEM IN TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
TAGBILARAN CITY DIVISION OFFICE**

TO All Division Office Personnel
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
Teaching and Nonteaching Personnel
All Others Concerned

1. As provided in Article 2, Section 15 of the Philippine Constitution, *The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and in still health consciousness among them.*
2. On March 8, 2020, Presidential Proclamation No. 922 was issued declaring the country in a State of Public Health Emergency in relation to COVID-19 after the World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 as a pandemic.
3. On March 23, 2020, Proclamation 929 was likewise issued placing the entire Philippines under the state of calamity to allow the government to tap more funds to contain the spread of COVID-19.
4. Republic Act No. 11332 known as the “Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act” requires the mandatory reporting reportable disease and health events of public health concern as well as rapid containment and implementation of measures for disease prevention and control.
5. The City Government of Tagbilaran issued Executive Order No. 41 s. 2020 titled *“An Executive Order on the Use of Quick Response (QR) Coded Contact Tracing System and Requiring all Persons Who Are Inhabitants of the City to Register their Basic Personal Information in their Respective Barangays and to Present the Quick Response (QR) Code when Transacting Business with Public and Private Establishment within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the City Of Tagbilaran.*
6. In view of the foregoing and as remarkably proven effective by public health experts in countries like Singapore, China, Taiwan and South Korea in helping public offices control the spread of COVID-19, effective **March 1, 2021**, this Office requires all transacting public to present their Quick Response (QR) Code to the designated personnel.
