

This email is in reference to the Amendment of Section 53 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11310 or the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps Act), which the Department of Social Welfare and Development is conducting a National Survey to gain insights on public opinion prior to the conduct of public consultations.

Section 16 of 4Ps Act and Section 52 of Rule XIX of its IRR states that an Independent Monitoring Committee (IMC) shall be created at the national and regional levels, composed of representatives from the private sector and civil society organizations (CSOs), subject to the criteria to be developed by the DSWD, to complement the monitoring activities of the DSWD and provide feedback for appropriate action. Its establishment is aligned with the Department's policies on transparency, accountability, participation, equity, and quality assurance.

The survey seeks responses on the proposed removal of items B and C under Section 53:

- A. Monitor the inter-agency implementation of the Program at all levels;
- B. Participate in the review and assessment of qualified household-beneficiary and LGU compliance to conditions;
