Photography theme:

This contest is an avenue for all government officials and employees to showcase their creativity through photography regardless of employment status. It is open to all CSC employees including their relatives up to second degree of consanguinity.

Each participant is allowed to submit only one (1) entry of image that depicts the resiliency and dedication of government employees to serve the country amidst the challenges faced during this pandemic. A photo shall be taken from June 1, 2021 to July 30, 2021. Entries shall be submitted only through cscro7@yahoo.com not later than 5 p.m. of 30 July 2021.

MECHANICS OF THE 2021 PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

Theme: "Pagtugon ng Lingkod Bayani sa Patuloy na Hamon ng Pandemya"

MECHANICS

I. Theme

This year's photography contest theme is "*Pagtugon ng Lingkod Bayani sa Patuloy na Hamon ng Pandemya*".

II. Date of Launching

The Contest will be launched on 1 July 2021 and the awarding of winners will be held on 22 September 2021.

III. Eligible contestants

The contest is open to all government workers regardless of employment status except employees of the CSC including their relatives up to second degree of affinity or consanguinity.

IV. Submission of Entries

At the Regional Level:

1. Each participant is allowed to submit only ONE (1) entry. Upon submission of entry, the contestants grant the Civil Service Commission full permission to use the photos in any CSC material.
2. Entries shall be submitted to the official email addresses of CSC Regional Office which has jurisdiction over the participants.
3. CSC Regional Offices shall only accept entries submitted through email. Those submitted through other means shall be automatically disqualified.
4. Entries to be submitted shall include the following details:
 - 4.1 Name, sex, age, email address, contact number, and agency name of participant
 - 4.2 Photograph Title
 - 4.3 Photograph Caption (1-2 sentences describing the photograph and its relevance to the theme)

- 4.4 Place where the photograph was taken (barangay, town/municipality, city, province, region)
 - 4.5 Date when photograph was taken
 - 4.6 Camera/device used
5. File name of photographs should be in the following format:
SURNAME, First Name, Middle Initial.

V. Photograph Image/Requirements

- 1. Photographs must be all original and must not contain copyrighted materials. Only colored photographs will be considered. Black and white or sepia photographs will be automatically disqualified.
- 2. Photographs must be in digital JPEG or JPG format (horizontal image or vertical image) with at least 300 dpi and maximum file size of 10MB.
- 3. Photographs must not be digitally altered (colorized, toned, assembled, blended, stitched panorama, etc.) and/or enhanced in any way.
- 4. Watermarked photographs and those that have been previously submitted or have won in any local or international photography contest will be disqualified.
- 5. Photographs to be submitted must be taken starting 1 July 2021, the official launch of the photography contest, until 5 p.m. of 30 July 2021.

VI. Criteria for Judging

The criteria for judging will be as follows:

• Content and Adherence to Theme	-	30%
• Visual Impact (including color and lighting)	-	25%
• Creativity and Originality	-	25%
• Photograph Quality	-	<u>20%</u>
Total		100%

VII. Selection of Winners

- 1. For regional screening, each CSC Regional Office will select its own panel of judges to deliberate which of the top three (3) entries shall be forwarded to the CSC Central Office on or before 20 August 2021 for inclusion as contestants at the national level.

2. Final screening at the CSC Central Office: The panel of judges will screen all the winning entries from the CSC Regional Offices. The Human Resource Relations Office (HRRO) which shall act as the Secretariat shall ensure that the participants have complied with the prescribed guidelines and the photographs do not depict violence, nudity, or obscenity;
3. The judges will select the top three (3) entries to be awarded the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes on 22 September 2021. The decision of the judges shall be final and not appealable.
