**ADVISORY TO DEPED REGIONAL DIRECTORS, SDO SUPERINTENDENTS, AND
PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL HEADS ON LEARNING
DELIVERY MODALITIES 1 (LDM) IMPLEMENTATION ASSESSMENT (ENDLINE)
AND OTHER CONCERNS**


As part of the after-training activities of the LDM 1 course (Management of LDM Implementation) for school heads, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) informs school heads to access and accomplish the Learning Delivery Modalities Implementation Assessment Survey (endline) through bit.ly/ladmendline on or before **30 July 2021**.

This end-line survey will help assess some aspects of a school's LDM implementation, identify notable practices and lingering challenges, and enumerate preparations for a possible limited face-to-face classes next school year.

While the accomplished LDM implementation assessment tool is not a required artifact in the LDM 1 practicum portfolio, school heads are advised to keep an active copy of it and use the results for action planning and decision-making. The endline tool may also be added in the practicum portfolio as a self-selected artifact. Further, data from the baseline, midline, and endline tools may also be used for the School Report Card (SRC). The endline tool and submission details are posted in the given link.

LDM Form Managers at the SDO and RO levels are advised that the deadline for submission for all Forms 4 and 4P (division /regional list of pre-implementation and practicum part completers) is extended on or before **27 August 2021**, provided that the Regional Directors are informed about the extension request. Should there be queries regarding the submission of the aforementioned forms, form managers may contact the National Educators Academy of the Philippines through lcpcapbldg@gmail.com.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can I use my LDM certificate for my application for reclassification/promotion?**

Yes, LDM certificates can be used by any LDM participants in their application for reclassification/promotion. A memo on this addressed to field offices has been issued.
- 2. Can I use my pre-implementation outputs in my practicum portfolio?**



For your pre-implementation portfolio, this should only contain the required outputs in each module. These outputs are indicated in the course introduction/overview module also. You are not required to submit your study notebook.

NEAP released last April the list of required outputs for your practicum portfolio (as discussed in Module 5 or Module 7)) to guide you in building it. Visit bit.ly/l dm portfolio eval. Most of these practicum artifacts/MOVs are outputs that you already have as part of your daily practice, and some can also be used for your RPMS portfolio this school year. These practicum outputs are evidence of how you applied what you have learned from the LDM course.
- 3. I haven't received my LDM certificate of participation. What shall I do?**



You may coordinate with your SDO LDM PMT (SGOD-HRDS) as they are the ones coordinating with the regional LDM PMT (NEAP-R/HRDD). It's the region who will issue your LDM certificates of participation and completion.



Frequently Asked Questions	
<p>5. Is it okay not to have self-selected artifacts/MOVs in our practicum portfolio?</p>	<p>If you think that the required outputs already sufficiently satisfy the evaluation criteria, you may do away with the self-selected outputs. Our recommendation is that you still include self-selected outputs from (or even not from) the list to demonstrate application of learning. But please note that the portfolio is not a scrapbook where you put everything in it.</p>
<p>6. I am not a supervisor but I served as Instructional Coach in LDM 2. Which practicum portfolio guide should I use?</p>	<p>The practicum portfolio guide for supervisors, including the list of artifacts/MOVs, is applicable to all coaches regardless of position. If the coach is a teacher or school head, this particular role can be used in the RPMS corresponding to either highly proficient or distinguished career stage. You just have to match the artifact/MOV to the appropriate strand and career stage relative to the position of the personnel who served as Instructional Coach but is not a supervisor.</p>
<p>7. Should I include the study notebook in my practicum portfolio?</p>	<p>You may still include your study notebook as a self-selected artifact, but it is advised that you keep it (or a copy of it) as this may be useful when you need to go back to your own learning notes.</p>

Frequently Asked Questions	
<p>8. What would be the set of practicum portfolio required artifacts of department heads who were not assigned as LDM2 school LAC Leaders?</p>	<p>Outputs expected from department heads would depend on their participation in LDM2--either as a school LAC leader or a teacher-participant.</p> <p>If they did not take the pre-implementation part of the LDM 2 course, they are not considered as course participants, hence, are not expected to submit the practicum portfolio.</p>
<p>9. Can the artifacts submitted for the pre-implementation modules be used again in the practicum portfolio?</p>	<p>Yes, to a certain extent--if you pair it with the updated/improved version to highlight the learnings you have gained throughout the school year.</p> <p>Ex. Pre-implementation output ILMP/WHLP + Q3/Q4 ILMP/WHLP</p>
<p>10. Is the evaluation rubric for teachers similar to that for the School LAC Leaders?</p>	<p>The same set of criteria/rubrics is used in all LDM courses.</p>

Frequently Asked Questions

11. I am a school head and took the LDM1 course and consequently submitted the pre-implementation module outputs. Then, I was assigned to serve as LDM 2 School LAC Leader/ LDM2 Instructional Coach. Do I submit two practicum portfolios--for LDM1 and LDM2?

You only need to submit one (1) LDM practicum portfolio--for LDM1--since it's the course that is intended for you--aligned to the professional standards for school heads, and you have submitted the pre-implementation outputs for it. LDM2-related artifacts may also be added in your LDM1 practicum portfolio under self-selected artifacts. You just have to map the PPSSH indicators that these LDM2 artifacts cover.
