

Subject: **2021 GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY**

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in partnership with the Department of Health (DOH), World Health Organization (WHO), and United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), shall organize **this year's celebration of the Global Handwashing Day** with the theme: *Our Future is at Hand – Let's Move Forward Together*. This global advocacy day is celebrated every 15th of October and is dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding on the importance of handwashing with soap as an effective and affordable way to prevent diseases and save lives.

In line with the said celebration, a one-day symposium titled *Malinis na Kamay para sa Kinabukasan ng Bayan* will be conducted on **15 October 2021, Friday, 1:00 – 3:30 p.m.** via the **DepEd Philippines Facebook Page**. Kindly see the attached **Program** for more details (Annex A).

This activity aims to motivate key stakeholders to promote a culture of hand hygiene by featuring best practices on encouraging handwashing behavior across different settings. To adapt to current learning modalities, the event shall feature **selected videos submitted by regions**. These will highlight various initiatives in the implementation of WinS Program at the school level. Further, this event shall launch the WASH O'clock campaign as a platform for public awareness, advocacy and social mobilization in selected areas.
