1. In celebration of **2021 National Reading Month** bearing the theme, “**Bawat Bata Bumabasa sa Kabila ng Hamon ng Pandemya**”, this Office announces the conduct of the Reading Cup which will run starting November 8 until November 27, 2021.
2. Reading Cup is a gamified reading contest using the Reading Progress Tool which aims to assess the reading fluency level of students from Grades 7-12.
3. Secondary School Principals are to provide the Office through the Education Supervisor in English, a list of student participants to the event on or before November 7, 2021. They are also asked to facilitate the enrolment of the participants to the Regional Team. Likewise, they are to monitor the progress of the participants from kick-off to the final round.

5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.

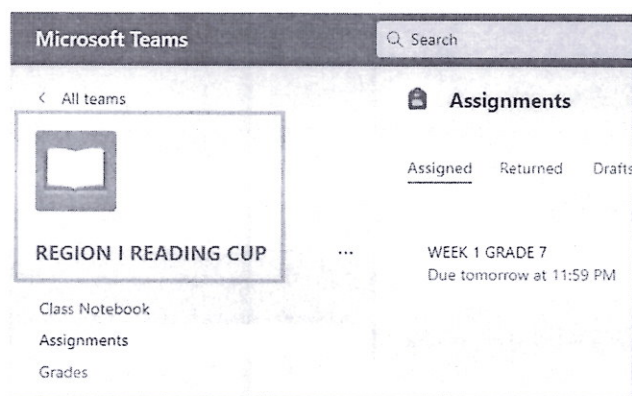
Contest Mechanics: Reading Cup

Contest description: Reading Cup is a gamified regional reading contest through *Reading Progress*. This activity aims to assess the reading fluency level of students and showcase exemplar readers across regions.

Contestants: All students from **Grade levels 7 – 12** of all regions are invited to participate.

Mechanics:

1. Bureau of Learning Delivery will post **codes** per region on **DepEd Philippines Facebook page**.
2. Participants will input the code to **MS Teams** app to join to their **Regional Team**.



3. Participants will **select** the reading material designated to their **grade level**.
4. Participants will record themselves reading the selection. Students are allowed to have 3 attempts before submitting their reading entry.

5. Weekly reading leaderboards will be posted on **DepEd Philippines Facebook page** to recognize top readers based on the Reading Progress insights.
6. Top readers from week 1 and week 2 will advance to the **finals** on November 22, 2021. **Top 3 winners** in the final round will be recognized on the **Culminating Activity** on **November 26**.
