1. 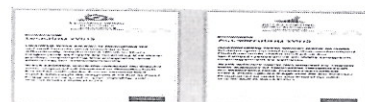
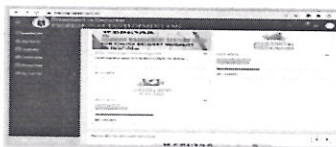
- Click "Continue" to confirm your new account

- Click "Access" , enter the enrollment Key ____ click "Enroll me"



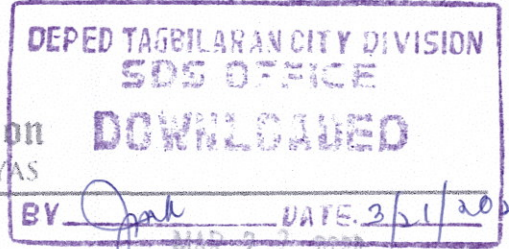
NAVIGATING THE WEBSITE

- Click on the navigation bar to go the site home and display all your enrolled training.deped.gov.ph courses.
- Look for the School Health Division Category. Then, select WASH in School/WinS MOOC. Finally, select the assigned course.
- WinS Courses can be found under the School Health Division- WinS MOOC. Use the search bar to search for a specific course. Leading WinS / Accelerating WinS
- In Answering Forums, Click on the "Add a New Discussion Topic" button to answer the questions and submit reflections. Remember to post a reply on the response of atleast two of your fellow learners.
- To add an image click the insert image icon. Paste the image link in the "Enter URL", tick the "This image is decorative only" and click "Save Image".
- In Submitting a reflection, Click on the "ADD SUBMISSION" button and Type in your reflections. The Page will be reloaded then you have to scroll down to submit your reflection or work.

**2022 MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE (MOOC) ON WASH IN SCHOOLS
(WinS) ACCELERATING WinS and LEADING WinS**

1. In this current pandemic situation, improvement of WASH at the school level has become the requirement to meet the minimum health standards and ensure that proper hygiene will be practiced by learners, parents and Department of Education (DepED) personnel despite of the no face to face scheme in our school and in preparation for the opening of schools.

2. In view thereof, as part of the DepED's response to the pandemic, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) is implementing series of **Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) on WinS** as a digital training solution to have a uniform delivery of the program's context to target audiences. 

Subject: **ENDORSEMENT OF THE 2022 WinS MOOCs**

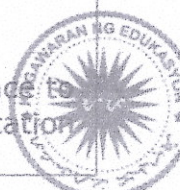
The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) will conduct the Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) in two (2) batches this year. These MOOCs shall be composed of the **Leading WinS** and **Accelerating WinS** which aim to accelerate the improvement of WASH status in schools.

The implementation of these virtual capacity building initiatives is required in meeting the minimum health standards and in ensuring that proper hygiene can be practiced by learners and DepEd personnel in the current situation and once schools reopen at some point in the future. This is in accordance with DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2020.


IV. Target Number of Participants
