- b. Select the title of the program of choice and access the course.



7. All NEAP SIM Card recipients will receive their top up load (NEAP Package 379). On the other hand, public school teachers who were not given NEAP SIM Cards may opt to have their communications expense reimbursed following the usual procedure for the reimbursement of communications expenses and including a copy or screenshot of his/her registration to any of the programs listed above.
