1. Pursuant to BSP Council Memorandum No. 21, s.2022, this office announces and encourages all registered members of the **Boy Scouts of the Philippines** to participate in the following training schedules for the year 2022 at **Roxas Park, Calma, Garcia Hernandez, Bohol**.
 - i. **July 12-14, 2022**
Basic Training Course for Leaders of Adults (School Administrators)
Basic Training Course for Langkay Leaders (Prep Teachers)
 - ii. **July 19-21, 2022**
Basic Training Course for Outfit Advisors (Junior High School Teachers)
Basic Training Course for Circle Mangers (Senior High School Teachers)
Council Summer/ Survival Camp for Venturer and Eagle Scout Applicants
 - iii. **July 26-28, 2022**
Basic Training Course for Troop Leaders (Grades 4-6 Teachers)
Basic Training Course for Kawan Leaders (Grades 13 Teachers)
2. These will all be face-to-face courses for teachers who are handling scouts. There will also be a Council Board of Review for scouts aspiring for the Eagle Scout Rank.
3. Registration fee for the cost of meals/snacks and activity materials will be **One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00)**. Registration, transportation, and other incidental expenses can be charged to the School MOOE, PTA Funds or to any available school funds.
4. All participants will assemble at the venue at exactly 8:00 o'clock in the morning on the first day of the above-mentioned schedule in scout or scouter's uniform.
5. Only maximum of 50 participants will be accepted in each course. Thus, first come first serve shall be observed. Participating teachers in these trainings





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are entitled to service credits in accordance with the existing rules and guidelines.

6. These will all be live-in trainings. Thus, all participants are advised to bring the following:
 - a. Scout/scouter's uniform (Type A & B)
 - b. Extra t-shirts, personal belongings & toiletries
 - c. Beddings/mess kit
 - d. Individual dome tent with sleeping gears
 - e. Swimming attire
 - f. Compass, knot tying/lashing ropes (5meters long), morse code flags and knife/bolo for scouts participating in the summer/survival camp
 - g. Parent's consent for scouts
7. All participants must be **fully vaccinated** and should abide the health protocols such as the wearing of facemasks, washing of hands with alcohol, social distancing, and temperature checking.




