1. In preparation for the opening of classes for School Year 2022-2023 by August 22, 2022, and in reference to OULAPPP No. Q-285, s. 2022 announcing the 2022 Brigada Eskwela National Kick-Off in Baguio City on August 1, 2022, all DepEd Tagbilaran City officials, School Heads, and teachers are enjoined to participate in the National Kick-off program via FB DepEd Tayo.

2. 3. This year's BE shall focus on the following:

- a) Implementation of the year-round schools' maintenance and repair activities, which includes the provision of the immediate needs during a disaster or calamities, and the addressing of resource gaps during the reopening of the face-to-face classes.
- b) Strengthen partnerships with partners and stakeholders to supplement DepEd's efforts to ensure quality basic education.
- c) Achievement of critical goals that will increase student engagement, reduce dropouts, and aid improve learning for both students and the community; and
- d) Establish a network of community-based organizations to obtain full community support for collaborative programs and initiatives, including Brigada Pagbasa and other support and volunteer/community-based projects.

4. Teachers involved in the preparation and conduct of the Brigada Eskwela activities from August 8 to 21, 2022, will be given service credits proportional to their actual number of hours rendered translated into hours equivalent days and not more than fifteen days.


5. In this connection, Brigada Coordinators, Adopt-A-School Coordinators, and the Schools SBM Coordinator will document the conduct of the activity and use the Brigada Eskwela Forms 1 to 7 in preparation for the coming search for Best Brigada Eskwela Implementers.

6. In compliance with the strict implementation of health protocols for onsite activity, participants are requested to comply with the mandatory wearing of a facemask and health

protocols during school entrance. Schools with early morning caravans should ask for a barangay clearance from their respective barangay offices.

7. Expenses relative to and in the conduct of the 2022 Brigada Eskwela Simultaneous Kick-Off activities shall be charged to the Division Program Support Fund for Partnership under – Adopt-A-School Program, while School Kick-off activities shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting & auditing rules and regulations.

8. Wide dissemination and compliance of this memorandum are desired.
