DENGUE PREVENTION AND CONTROL IN SCHOOL

To: Division School Health and Nutrition Personnel
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
Teaching and Non-teaching Personnel
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to Memorandum Circular 2022-009 from the Office of the Governor, directing the conduct of intensified and sustained anti-dengue campaign and efforts in all barangays of this province. this office through the School Governance Operations Division School Health and Nutrition Section reiterates the importance of taking actions to monitor, prevent and control the spread of Dengue to protect the school populace.
2. As part of the intensive dengue campaign drive, the following measures must be observed:
 - a. Emphasize the 4S strategy which stands for **S**earch and destroy mosquito breeding places; **S**ecure self-protection measures; **S**eek early consultation and **S**upport fogging/spraying in hot spot areas to prevent impending outbreak.
 - b. Report dengue cases to the nearest Barangay Health Center.
 - c. Create awareness about dengue by hanging of tarpaulins, dissemination of pamphlets or IEC material and integrate topics on dengue during classes or lectures.

4. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this memorandum is desired.

SUBJECT: DIRECTING THE CONDUCT OF INTENSIFIED AND SUSTAINED ANTI-DENGUE CAMPAIGN AND EFFORTS IN ALL BARANGAYS OF THIS PROVINCE

Dengue, a fatal infectious disease perennially affecting our constituents, is once again in resurgence in our province threatening lives and compromising the health of communities.

PREVENTION - *i.e.*, the identification and destruction of breeding sites of dengue's vectors (*Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus* - both day biting mosquitos) and GOOD ENVIRONMENTAL SANITATION, are effective ways to contain the spread of the disease. These measures can be successfully carried out with the active and sustained participation of the community, starting with every household.

In order to promote and ensure the protection of the health and safety of our constituents, all Mayors and Punong Barangays, assisted by their respective health units are directed;

1. Organize Municipal/ City Anti-Dengue Campaign Committees tasked to:
 - a. Advocate an active and sustained anti-dengue drive through the 4S Strategy;
 - b. Direct simultaneous search-and-destroy and clean-up drives directed at mosquito breeding sites in all barangays in your areas of responsibility;
 - c. Provide technical and logistical support to the Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD)

2. Organize functional Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD) Task Forces in all barangays tasked to:
 - a. Advocate and implement active and sustained anti-dengue activities through massive and house-to-house information dissemination;
 - b. Develop an effective dengue control plan and put the same into effort on a sustained basis using the 4S Strategy promoted by the Department of Health;
 - c. Spearhead weekly barangay clean-up drive and search-and-destroy operations directed at mosquito breeding sites;
 - d. Organize Purok Dengue Brigades to ensure a grassroots anti-dengue drive.

The City and Municipal Health Officers shall ensure effective monitoring of dengue cases and facilitate early medical intervention to dengue suspects. They shall be assisted by their network of support – public health nurses, rural health midwives, sanitary inspectors, NDPs and BHWs.

Local Chief Executives shall coordinate with DepEd authorities and PTA Officers to complement our anti- dengue drive in schools.

Every LGU shall allocate modest support funds for the operationalization of this program.

For your proper guidance and kind observance to ensure continuity of the service and to serve the best interest of the public.
