 - b. Coordinate with Land Transportation Office (LTO) to conduct Orientation on Safety Driving tips for learners and personnel.
2. All expenses incurred in the conduct of the above-mentioned activities shall be chargeable to MOOE or any available local funds subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
3. Immediate dissemination and appropriate action to this Memorandum is desired.

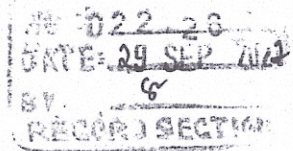

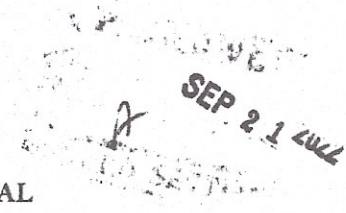

Esparcia died at 1:30 in the afternoon of the same day due to a reason that his bigger blood vessel in the head burst. The child was playing in their house the day before his death and another family member also said that the child is always expose to using cellphone which for them is one of the reason why the child experienced severe headache. The day of September 17, 2022 (Saturday) when the child collapsed the family brought him to Provincial Hospital unfortunately, the child was not saved due to extreme bursting of blood.

INCIDENT REPORT

Last September 19, 2022, Monday, during the students' dismissal at around 5:00 pm, a motor accident happened at the Balugo Road, Balugo, Valencia, Negros Oriental fronting the newly constructed gymnasium which is about 200m away from the school gate and which involved two of our students; **Jeslier Ijan (Grade 8)** and **Saint John Lumoya (Grade 12 – SMAW)**. Based on the statements of witnesses, Jeslier was crossing towards the other side of the road when Saint John driving a motorcycle in a fast speed bumped him which resulted to several injuries. Witnesses immediately called for an ambulance and in which also responded right away. Jeslier Ijan who had severe injuries was then brought to Silliman University Medical Center while Saint John Lumoya was also brought to the Valencia RHU for minor bruises medication.
