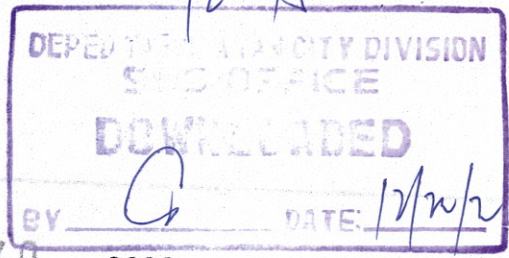

Procedure and Criteria for Selecting the “DISTINGUISHED FAPSA NATIONAL LEADERS AND TEACHERS”

OVERVIEW

The distinction/merit for FAPSA NATIONAL LEADERS and TEACHERS to include the private school owners, administrators and teachers, among others is an opportunity for all stakeholders to share the remarkable stories about the excellence displayed with their respective private schools. Individuals recognized will exemplify the strengths, integrity, and leadership of our schools, the support and commitment of the community, and the many notable outcomes of our efforts to deliver and improve Private School Education in the country. Nominations shall be made by the private school administrators and local FAPSA Officer. Final winners will be notified via Email and Phone by the judging team. Accurate email addresses and phone numbers are required for the honor to be considered.

PROCEDURE

1. Each private school shall device its own method for selecting its nominees based on the criteria listed herein;
2. There shall only be one (1) nominee for each department, namely: (a) Preschool [Nursery, Kindergarten, or Preparatory]; (b) Elementary; (c) Junior High School; (d) Senior High School; and (e) Tertiary, for each private school;
3. For the teachers from the private basic education from Preschool to Senior High School, the teacher must be a holder of unexpired professional license; and for the private tertiary level, the teacher must be a graduate of least master's degree;
4. The distinction/merit will be given during the FAPSA 25th Anniversary on February 02, 2023 (Thursday) at the Manila Hotel;

CRITERIA

The HONOREE must Exhibit and Advocate the following characteristics of a worthy Private Educator.

No.	Indicators/Characteristics	Remarks
1	Commitment to Quality Education/UN Sustainable Development Goal No. 4 especially one's commitment to excellence that advances student learning, broad private school community representation, and diverse evaluation protocols to assure inclusion and quality	
2	Strong belief in the value of a private education and commitment to its advancement in significant ways	
3	Instructional Innovation and Creativity	
4	High Performance of current students and graduates	
5	Significant and Professional Service through one's passion for education and the community served	
6	Must be of service of the present private school for at least five (5) years and models integrity, fairness, compassion, and resiliency	
7	Must not have any pending case involving moral torpitude	

NOTE: Virtual or In-Person interview may be conducted for verification purposes or as may be decided by the judging team. The decision of the judging team shall be considered final and shall be free from all questions.
