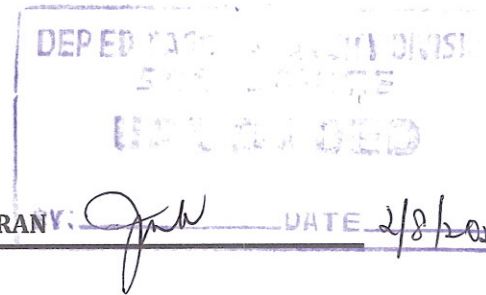

BRIGADA ESKWELA 2022 BEST IMPLEMENTING SCHOOL AWARD

1. This office is hereby announcing the search for the 2022 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Award in accordance with DepEd Memorandum 062, s 2022, also known as the 2022 Brigada Eskwela Implementing Guidelines.

2. The coverage of the contest shall be from June 01, 2022, to September 30 2022, and shall focus on the Five (5) major BE components namely: Brigada Eskwela School Preparation Effort (25%), Brigada Eskwela Partnerships Engagement Activities (25%), Brigada Eskwela Impact to School Performance (25%), Brigada Eskwela Resources Generated (15%), Bayanihan Effort to support the Brigada Eskwela implementation (10%).

3. A winner shall be selected for each category (Small, Medium, Large, Mega) for elementary and secondary schools following the guidelines in DepEd Memorandum 062, s 2022. A lone school under such category should reached Very Satisfactory Rating to be given the award. Aside from the traditional Best Brigada Eskwela Implementing School Award, one (1) elementary and one (1) secondary public school shall be chosen for the National Special Awards for the following categories:.

- 3.1 Brigada Pagbasa Advocacy Award
- 3.2 Functional Home Learning Spaces Award

4. A Brigada Eskwela Division Selection Committee that will determine the winners are composed of selected CID and SGOD personnel shall shortlist the schools based on the BE Documents and Videos submitted. The review and validation shall be conducted on **February 20-24, 2023**, at the Division Office, and the Division winners shall be announced on or before **March 15, 2023**.
