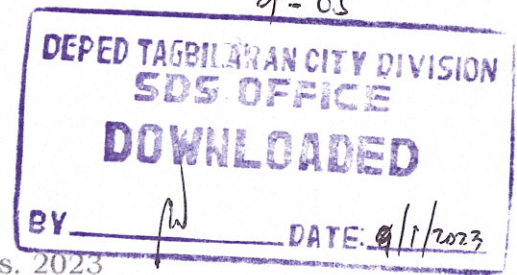

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The grantee shall be a bonafide active member of good standing of the Association continuously for at least two (2) years, not more than 60 years old, prior to availment of the scholarship grant.
2. The availment shall be utilized to pursue a post graduate study or education-related course.
3. The grantee shall be currently enrolled at the time of availment.

4. The financial assistance is a one-time benefit program to be given in full amount of Twenty Thousand Pesos (Php20,000.00) upon presentation of the following:

- 4.1. Requirements
 - a. Letter of Intent
 - b. Personal Information Sheet
 - c. Proof of Enrolment (School Registration, Certification, etc.)
 - d. Two (2) Valid Identification Card (ID)
- 4.2. A grantee may avail an additional amount of Fifteen Thousand Pesos (Php15,000.00) once he/she is on thesis/dissertation writing after the approval of its proposal.
- 4.3. Requirements of applicant for this benefit shall be submitted to the Scholarship Committee to check its veracity and recommend the same to the office of the General Manager for approval.
- 4.4. Check shall be issued in the name of the grantee.

5. Availments of educational financial assistance shall be on a first come, first served basis.

6. Grantees from each region shall be proportionate to the total number of members per region based on the Association's current year approved budget. The grantees shall be endorsed by the concerned PPSTA Board of Trustees.


7. The grantee shall sign a commitment agreement to continue membership unless resigned/retired in service or until maturity of policy.
