SUBJECT : **Writeshop on ALS SHS Learning Activity Sheets MELCs-Based Curriculum for Quarters 2 and 3**

DATE : **November 6, 2023**

1. Through DepEd Order no. 13, s. 2029 (Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of Enhanced ALS 2.0), DepEd is mandated to include the Senior High School (SHS) level in the ALS Program, equivalent to Grade 11 and 12 in the formal education system. This is further strengthened with the passage of Republic Act no. 11510 (ALS Act) in December 2020, where it is emphasized that ALS JHS passers are qualified to enroll in Senior High School or selected technical vocational education training programs through TESDA.
2. In response, our division piloted the ALS Senior High School in Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School offering TVL track with various majors including Cookery, Caregiving, Housekeeping, SMAW, EIM, Food and Beverages Services, Bartending, and Food Processing.
3. To provide essential support, particularly in terms of learning materials, this Office announces the conduct of Writeshop on ALS SHS Learning Activity Sheets MELCs-Based Curriculum for Quarter 2 and 3 on November 11, 18, and 25, 2023. Venue is still to be determined.
4. This activity aims to develop a localized ALS SHS MELCs-Based LAS and subject it for critique before uploading it to the learning resource portal.



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5. Participants in this activity include 17 ALS SHS teachers, ALS SHS School Head, EPS II-ALS, EPSvr in LRMDs, Division ALS Focal, SGOD M&E, and CID-Chief.
6. ALS SHS teachers are entitled to service credits pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. Moreover, Related-Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered.
7. Training expenses relative to the conduct of this activity are chargeable against ALS Program Support Funds while travel expenses shall be charged to the school MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations prescribed by the Commission on Audit.
