The Provincial Government of Bohol Center for Culture & Arts Development (CCAD) through the Bohol Arts and Cultural Heritage (BACH) Council- Literary Arts Committee and Languages Committee in cooperation with Kaliwat ni Karyapa (KaKa), calls for participation in this year's Tagik Balak Writing Competition on November 22, 2023, at the Panda Tea Garden Suites.

Guidelines:

1. The competition is open to:
 - a. Group A: Secondary and Tertiary Students- both from public and private schools in Bohol.
 - b. Group B: Open Group- for all Boholano young adults/adults from all walks of life.
2. Schools can send one participant only. Participants are encouraged to wear their school uniforms during the contest.
3. Registration of participants will be held at the venue from 9:00 am to 10:00 am on November 22, 2023, at the Panda Tea Garden Suites.
4. Participants will be given their entry numbers.
5. While the theme is open, the balak must highlight Bohol in any way. The contest will commence at 1:30 pm.
6. Using dictionaries (print or online) is prohibited.
7. Adherence to the contest guidelines must be strictly observed. Non-compliance will automatically disqualify the entry.
8. Winners will be announced through the CCAD and Kaliwat ni Karyapa Facebook pages. Awarding will be on December 8, 2023, during the Hudyaka sa Pasko at the Provincial Capitol Grounds. The decision of the judges is final.
9. Winning works will be published in an anthology in print format, to be released in 2024. Winners will receive one copy of the book.
10. All rights revert to the authors upon publication of the anthology/book. Center for Culture and Arts Development (CCAD), Literary Arts Committee and Languages Committee of the Bohol Arts and Cultural Heritage (BACH) Council, and Kaliwat ni Karyapa require First Rights from the winners, meaning the aforementioned organizations reserve the right to be the first entities to present the selected works to the public, in print or online.
