The Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Bohol Girl Scout Council is excited to announce that after a six-year hiatus from province-wide camping due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the **PROVINCIAL JUNIOR, SENIOR, AND CADET CAMP** will finally take place on **March 22-24, 2024**.

Themed: **“75 Years of Empowering Girls and Young Women: Celebrating Our Legacy, Inspiring Our Future”**, the camping event will be hosted by **Valencia District** at the **Valencia Camping Center** in **Barangay Poblacion, Valencia, Bohol**.

Hereunder are the pertinent details of said provincial camp:

### Qualifications of Campers

- Girls**
- Must be registered Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scout as of March 31, 2024
  - Must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
  - Must have earned at least one (1) badge under the Eight-Point Challenge
  - Must have experienced/participated a troop/school/district/provincial camp

- Adults**
- Must be registered Troop Leader as of March 31, 2024
  - Must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
  - Must know and understand her girls
  - Must know the basics of First Aid
  - Must have undertaken the Basic Course and Outdoor Leadership Course
  - Must have experienced/participated a troop/school/district/provincial camp

Participants must be screened and be given the needed pre-camp training during Girl Scouting time in school.

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## Camp Fee and Inclusions

One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per camper to cover for program materials, badges, souvenir bag, event t-shirt, and tour.

The camp registration fee and transportation/travelling expenses of the delegates may be charged to the Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund (SEF), District share of SMFC tickets, and local and other sources of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

## Things To Bring

### ▪ Individual/Personal Things ▪

- Two (2) sets of GSP Dress Uniform complete with GS paraphernalia and GS plain cap
- Two (2) sets of GSP Camp Uniform with green socks
- GSP Business Uniform with Adult pins and scarf
- GSP Alternate Uniform - white blouse, green pants & green vest
- GSP Black/Green Adult Polo Shirt
- Physical Fitness outfit: jogging pants and sweat shirt
- Sleeping garments (preferably pajamas)
- Comfortable working clothes
- Several changes of underwear
- Casual Dress
- Face and bath towels
- Outdoor beddings: oil cloth & blanket
- Bedroll/Sleeping bag
- Water canteen/Tumbler
- Set of eating utensils (plastic plate, spoon, fork, Cup and saucer, tumbler, knife, cloth napkin, all these placed in a drawstring bag)
- Wide-brim hat for Adult/Troop Leaders
- Scout Knife, Can Opener
- Sit-upon (a plastic sheet about 3ft. square)
- Raincoat
- Writing and art materials
- Flashlight, Sewing kit
- Toilet Articles (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.)
- Medical Certificate and Parent's Consent

### ▪ Patrol Equipment/Materials ▪

- Dome Tent enough for all campers
- Fly Tent for food supplies
- First Aid Kit with personal maintenance
- Materials for light gadgets like bamboo
- Cooking Utensils & materials/stove/coal/firewood
- Large plastic/black bag for litters enough for the duration
- Kerosene lantern/emergency lamp for quarters, dining & kitchen
- List of Contingents, Kaper's Chart, First Aid Kit
- Adequate food for camp duration
- Water jug/container
- Pails/dippers, basins
- Bolo/trowel, stick broom

## Arrival and Settling Down

The campers/contingents are expected to arrive at the campsite 5:00 p.m. onwards on March 21 (Thursday) until the morning of March 22 (Friday) not later than 7:00 a.m. complete with packed meals (dinner and/or breakfast), and all the things needed for the camping.

The Parade on March 22 will start at 8:30 in the morning to be followed by the Opening Ceremony.
