

- Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum is enjoined.



- 1. The 82<sup>nd</sup> Araw ng Kagitingan, also known as Day of Valor, commemorates the heroism of Filipino and American soldiers during the fall of Bataan in 1942. This day, observed on April 9<sup>th</sup>, honors those who fought bravely in World War II, highlighting the sacrifices made for freedom. Concurrently, the Philippine Veterans Week, celebrated from April 5 to 11, 2024, pays tribute to all veterans who served in various conflicts, recognizing their unwavering dedication and service to the nation. These events serve as poignant reminders of the courage and resilience embedded in the history of the Philippines.
- 2. The said celebrations are pursuant to Executive Order No. 203, s. 1987, titled Providing a List of Regular Holidays and Special Days to be Observed throughout the Philippines and for other Purposes which declared the 9th day of April as Araw ng Kagitingan (Bataan and Corregidor Day), Presidential Proclamation (PP) No. 466, s. 1989, titled Declaring the Period April 5 to 11 of every year as Philippine Veterans Week.
- The celebration of the Philippine Veterans Week and the 82<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary of the Araw ng Kagitingan will be on April 5 to 11, 2024 and on April 9, 2024, respectively.
- 4. The celebration aims to instill in the minds and hearts of the Filipino people especially the youth that the freedom the Filipinos enjoy today was nourished by the blood and sacrifices of their veteran forefathers.

- All government agencies including government-owned and controlled corporations, nongovernmental organizations, private associations, institutions, and individuals are enjoined to assist, cooperate, and participate in this historic commemoration.
- 6. In support of said commemorations, the Department of Education (DepEd), through its External Partnerships Service (EPS), and Curriculum and Teaching (CT), in cooperation with the Department of National Defense (DND), Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP), and Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO), shall conduct a Poster Making Contest, Oratorical, Essay Writing, and Song Writing Contest as part of said celebration. The contest mechanics are provided in the attached Enclosures 1, 2, and 3, respectively.
- 7. To make this year's celebration more meaningful, officials from the regional office, schools division office, and schools are encouraged to attend the program at all sites and venues, and to discuss the significance of Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week during classroom discussions. The following activities are also suggested for Araling Panlipunan (AP) and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) teachers to participate in.

a) integrate activities into related subject areas: (i) Sibika at kultura; (ii) Heograpiya, kasaykasayan at Sining (HEKASI); (iii) Araling Panlipunan; (iv) Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP); (v) Music, Arts, Physical Education and

Health (MAPEH); (vi) Filipino; and (vii) English; b) sharing of insights or other creative activities;

c) symposium or round table discussion to raise awareness on the event, and learn the values of nationalism, patriotism, and love of country which were exhibited by the veterans during the trying periods of this country;

d) putting up of bulletin board within the campus and displaying informative

materials concerning the commemorative events; and

e) does other related activities.

- 8. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of these activities shall be charged to local funds and regional/division MOOE. Meanwhile, the travel allowances and per diem of the DepEd Central Office and members of the Technical Working Group shall be charged against EPS funds, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

## CONTEST MECHANICS POSTER MAKING CONTEST

## 1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO), the Department of National Defense (DND), and the Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) are sponsoring a Poster-Making Contest.

The objectives of the contest typically include promoting awareness of the valor and sacrifices of Filipino veterans, fostering patriotism, encouraging creative expressions that honor the country's history and heroes, and the historical places in the Philippines during World War II where veterans fought for the country and sacrificed lives and to remember the reasons why we experience freedom up to this day.

## 2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, and 9 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of contests organized by the Special Events Unit are not eligible to participate, in order to give others a chance.

## 3. Scope/Theme

The entries should depict the life, works, and heroism of our Filipino heroes who fought for our country and should be in line with this year's theme: **BETERANO:** "PAGKILALA SA KATAPATAN, BALIK TANAW SA SAKRIPISYO AT PAG-ALAALA NG KABAYANIHAN"

#### 4. Entry Specification

Only entries submitted with correct and complete specifications and format will be considered official. Please take note of the following requirements to ensure that the entry satisfies the specifications of the contest:

- 4.1 The poster should be on a 15"x 20" illustration board.
- 4.2 Contestants may use any medium of his/her choice, (e.g. oil paste, crayon, and watercolor)
- 4.3 The poster must be described in one or two sentences. The description must be typewritten and printed on a ½ A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the entry together with the following information:
  - 4.3.1 Name of Learner
  - 4.3.2 Contact Number
  - 4.3.3 School
  - 4.3.4 Division

## 4.3.5 Region

4.4 The Philippine Flag should not be used as the background of the poster. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the artwork (please refer to Sec. 39 - Prohibited Acts under Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 titled "An Act Prescribing the Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines.").

## CONTEST MECHANICS SONG WRITING CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

## 1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 10, 11, and 12 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all the Special Events Unit organized contests are not qualified to join to give chance to others.

#### 2. Theme and Content

- 2.1 The song composition must fully describe KAGITINGAN through this year's theme, "PAGKILALA SA KATAPATAN, BALIK TANAW SA SAKRIPISYO AT PAG-ALAALA NG KABAYANIHAN."
- 2.2 The song entry must have a minimum duration of three (3) minutes and a maximum of four (4) minutes.
- 2.3 The lyrics and melody of the song should be original.
- 2.4 The song must not contain any vulgar, inappropriate, or offensive language.

#### 3. Criteria

3.1 Music	Creativity, Originality, Arrangement	50%
3.2 Lyrics	Content, Cohesiveness, Prose (structure)	30%
3.3 Overall Appeal	Concept, Impact, Recall	15%
3.4 Interpretation	Artist/ Musicality	5%

### 4. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The contestant who will get the highest score shall be considered the National Champion, the contestant with the second highest score shall be declared as the first runner-up, and the third highest shall be declared as the second runner-up, and so on and so forth.

Winners will be announced after the final competition, and will be awarded at Mt. Samat Shrine, Pilar, Bataan, on **April 9**, **2024**. The names of the winners, other details during the awarding and the process of claiming their prizes will be announced in a separate memo.

### 5. Submission of Entries

- 5.1 The deadline for the submission of entries will be on March 25, 2024, through this email, specialevents@deped.gov.ph
- 5.2 Only one (1) entry PER REGION is allowed. Each entry must be accompanied by the following requirements:
  - 5.2.1 Endorsement from the Region or Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) or the Chief of the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD).
  - 5.2.2 A certification from the school principal that the contestant is enrolled in the current School Year (2023-2024).
  - 5.2.3 Scanned image of the student ID, Principal's ID, & accomplish entry form.
- 4.4 The entry must be submitted in mp4 format properly labeled/titled together With the music sheet, lyrics, entry form, and bio-data of the composer.
- 4.5 An email shall be sent to the entrants' informing them that the entry has been received and if the entry has been officially accepted for the competition. The organizers shall not be responsible for late, lost, damaged, or misdirected entries.
- 5.6 Once submitted, all entries become the intellectual property of the PVAO, whether or not the song becomes the winning piece.

#### 6. Prizes

Winners for this year's competition will get cash prizes subject to the approval of the management and to the usual VFP accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
