The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), in partnership with the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH), will conduct a research and development project titled, **Career Development for Children (CD-IC): Technical Assistance on Developing Career Guidance Resources for Key Stage 1.**

This innovative endeavor aims to support the DepEd's Career Guidance Program (CGP) by developing evidence-based, age-appropriate, and culturally relevant teaching and learning resources for career guidance implementers.

Specifically, it focuses on:

1. shed light on how elementary-level career guidance implementers provide career guidance activities for key stage 1 learners and determine the needed teaching and learning resources that career guidance implementers can use to equip key stage 1 learners with age-appropriate career development skills.

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1. begin setting up with a baseline data/profile of public elementary-level career guidance implementation;
2. provide input on the design and implementation of a baseline CAP for DepEd's K-12 starting key stage; and
3. create career guidance designs and strategy resources specifically designed for key stage 1 learners.

The project consists of two phases: the research phase and the development phase. The *research phase* intends to review how elementary-level career guidance implementers provide career guidance activities for key stage 1 learners and determine the needed teaching and learning resources that career guidance implementers can use to equip key stage 1 learners with age-appropriate career development skills. The *development phase*, on the other hand, will focus on creating career guidance teaching and learning resources specifically designed for key stage 1 learners.

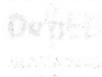
