3. Only the winning school paper advisers and coaches are allowed to participate in the 2024 NSPC. Selected non-teaching personnel from the division and region shall be utilized to form part of the regional delegation.
4. The **1st place Winners in the Individual Category** shall attend the enhancement training that shall be administered in preparation for the NSPC on May 20-22, 2024. The venue will be the **Deped Ecotech Training Center, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City**.
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against Division/School MOOE/local funds. Board and lodging of all participants shall be charged to Journalism Funds downloaded by the Central Office to the Regional Office and other available funds, such as seminar fund in journalism, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Campus journalists participating in this activity shall be on a Modular Distance Learning to guarantee that learning is maintained, while School Paper Advisers are directed to install a mechanism to ascertain that classes be attended by other available teachers.
7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
